Rice, paddy procurement drive progressing

RANGPUR, Jun 13: The procurement drive of Irri-Boro rice and paddy under the auspices of Food Department here has been

progressing fast, reports UNB. Official sources said about 620 metric tons of rice and 474 metric tons of paddy have been procured so far as against the target of 8,400 metric tons of rice and 12,000 metric tons of paddy. The government has fixed the price of paddy Tk 12 per kg and rice Tk 7.55 per kg for the current season. District Food Department has set up nine purchasing centres in the district to purchase the paddy and rice direct from the farmers. The procurement of wheat is also going on in the district. About 13,000 metric tons of wheat have so far been procured as against the target of 16,650 metric tons. Government rate is Tk 8.8 per kg of wheat for the current season.

Indian smuggled goods seized

FENI. Jun 13: Bangladesh Rifles seized a huge quantity of Indian smuggled goods worth about Tk 6.5 crore from different bordering areas of Feni and Noakhali districts during the last five months till May 30, reports UNB.

In 60 raids, led by deputy commander of rifles battalion-2 Major SM Mosharraf Hossain, the jawans also seize 20 trucks which were used for smuggling and arrested 10 people. The recovered goods included liquor, phensidyl, saree, timber, spices, powder milk, salt, sugar, utensils, Horlics, bicycle, were deposited with the district Customs and Forest offices.

The arrested were handed over to the police. Separate cases have been lodged.

350 bottles of phensidyl recovered

COMILLA, Jun 13: Police recovered 350 bottles of Indian phensidyl and arrested three people from a tempo at Kutombapur village in Chandina thana here on Thursday, reports UNB.

The arrested were identified as M Morhased Mia, Joynal and tempo driver M Masud. At the instruction of Additional Police Super Ali Akbar, DB Inspector Nazim Uddin searched the tempo at the village on Dhaka-Chittagong highway and recovered the contraband item. A case was registered with the police.

Headmaster killed by unknown assailants

JHENIDAH, Jun 13: The headmaster of Modhupur High School in Sadar thana was killed by some unknown assailants on Monday night, reports UNB.

Local people said pervious enmity on the post of the headmaster was the reason behind the murder of Mohammad Shahabuddin, 47. Police said the victim was staying at the school at night regularly to look after the circus show, which is going on for several days to collect fund for development of the school. At mid night on Monday some miscreants attacked and stabbed the headmaster seriously. He succumbed to his injuries later. Police recovered the dead body on the following morning and sent it to the Sadar hospital morgue for autopsy.

Construction of new school bldg begins

CHUADANGA, Jun 13: The construction of the two storled new building of local court para Jhenuk Government Primary School has just begun, reports BSS.

The Deputy Commissioner of Chuadanga Saiful Alam opened the construction of the building in presence of the members of the managing committee and teachers of the school on June 2. 
