Indian smuggled goods seized

COMILLA, June 16: Bangladesh Rifles seized huge quantity of Indian smuggled goods worth over Tk 60.70 lakh from different bordering areas of the district during the last month, reports UNB.

BDR sources said they also arrested six people and filed 189 cases during the period. The goods included sugar, saree, liquor, phenistyl, hemp, timber, spare parts of vehicles, pulses, salt, powder milk, clothes, spices, steel crockery, bicycle soap, brass and toys. The seized goods were deposited with the Customs godown.

Housewife commits suicide

MYMENSINGH, June 16: A housewife allegedly committed suicide by taking poison at Bawlia Bajur village in Valuka thana here on Monday, reports UNB.

The victim was identified as Minara Khatun, 30, wife of Shaque Uddin. Police sources said Minara developed an extra marital affair with Alam Mia of the same village. But she became extremely disheartened when Alam married another girl recently. Failing to bear the shock she allegedly committed suicide. A UD case was filed with police.

BUET teacher dead

CHUADANGA, June 16: Late Prof Dr M Mainul Hoque, Director, Institute of Appropriate Technology of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, was laid to rest at the graveyard adjacent to Baitul Moulta Mosque near Chuadanga Railway Station on Monday, reports BSS.

Late Mainul Hoque died of a heart attack in Dhaka on Sunday at the Suhrawardy Hospital. His second namaz-e-janaza was held at Baitul Moulta Mosque premises. Hundreds of people from all walks of life attended the janaza. Dr Hoque was the son of late Musdul Hoque of Chuadanga Kederganj Para. He left behind his daughter and a host of relatives to mourn his death.

3 youths caught with revolver

SIRAJGANJ, June 16: Three youths were caught along with a revolver and sharp knives while snatching valuables from a trader at Kamalpur in Shahjapur thana here on Sunday, reports UNB.

Police said local people caught the snatchers, identified as Abdul Momin, 20, Ajmal Hossain Apu, 21, and Bablu, 20, red handed while they were snatching Tk 10,000 and a wrist watch from Moksed Ali. The cloth trader Ali was returning home from Rupnai market at 9 pm on the day. People handed over the snatchers to police after a good beating. A case was filed with the police.

Steps to make IPM programme popular

SHERPUR, June 16: Agriculture Extension Department has undertaken various steps to make Integrated Pest Management (IPM) programme popular among the farmers across the country, reports UNB.

Scientists laid emphasis on utilising IPM and biological system to protect crops from pest-attack and other diseases. According to an estimate rampant use of pesticides has been degrading the ecological balance, affecting adversely 10-20 lakh people and killing at least 40,000 people every year in the world. With a view to providing practical training among the farmers, AED has established Farmers' Field Schools, demonstration plots and has been organising agri-fairs throughout the country.

STRP schemes progressing

CHUADANGA, June 16: The implementation of 167 small schemes under the Special Test Relief Programme (STRP) is in full swing in all the four thanas and three pourashavas of Chuadanga district in the current fiscal year, reports BSS.

The government sanctioned 212 metric tons of wheat for implementation of the schemes. According to an official source, 29 schemes are being implemented in Chuadanga sadar thana, 14 schemes in Alamdanga thana, 45 schemes in Damurhuda thana, 29 schemes in Jibannagar thana, 24 schemes in Chuadanga Pourashava, 23 schemes in Alamdanga Pourashava and three schemes in Jibannagar Pourashava.

Development projects being implemented

MANIKGANJ, June 16: Eight hundred and twenty six projects are being implemented by district relief and disaster management department under 'rural infrastructural and maintenance programme' in the seven thanas and one pourashava in the district in the current fiscal year, reports BSS.

The projects include repair and renovation of different kutchha roads, shishu sadan earth work in different educational and religious, institutions construction of the drains of deep tubewells and sinking of tubewells. A total of 3195 metric tons of wheat has been sanctioned for implementing the projects. The projects have generated employment opportunities for a large number of rural people in the district.

Flash flood submerges Daulatpur area in Kushtia

KUSHTIA, Jun 16: Low-lying areas of Daulatpur thana in the district have been submerged due to sudden rise in water level of the river Padma during the last one week.

Boro crops on vast tract of land have been submerged in flood water. Farmers of the area have been preparing now to harvest Boro paddy.

In the meantime, erosion of the river has been going on unabated in many places of the area. As a result many people have been affected. According to the local chairman of the union parishad, a total of 15,000 have so far been affected in 10 years due to river erosion.

The affected families are yet to be rehabilitated. Two villages namely Mohammadpur and Talpatty in Daulatpur thana have been separated from the mainland of Bangladesh. No steps have been taken to protect the affected people so far.

The local Land Office, Family Planning Centre, five mosques, five educational institutions of Chilmari union have been devoured in the river Padma last year. Huge tracts of cultivable land in 10 villages including Bazumara, Jotashahi, Chakrampur, Udaynagar and Bahirmadi have already gone under the river.

About 20,000 acres of land in 12 villages of Ramkrishnapur union have also been eroded.

A total of 2,000 families of these two unions have been living under open sky on the flood protection embankment. But the government have not
