# BFUJ, DUJ to mark Rush of patients hampers normal treatment at NICVD

Patient overcrowding the National Institute of Cardio Vascular Diseases (NICVD), is

seriously hampering normal treatment. "It is almost like a stampede situation here," said the hospital Director Professor MA Za-

man while talking to Daily Star on Tuesday. He said, "We have a bed capacity of 160 but instead we are compelled to accommodate more than 250 patients on an average. The situation deteriorated since past one year. Influx

of patients is putting extra bur-

den on us.

The hospital, considered by many as the only place for heart diseases treatment, can not refuse patients. Many insist on geiting admission on arrival before even understanding the severity of the ailment. One can only be hospitalised if the ailment case is very severe. But many patients demand admission for ordinary treatment.

By Staff Correspondent During a visit to various sections of the new and old building of the hospital yesterday, it

was noticed that in addition to normal beds, patients were accommodated on 'extra' beds. trolleys and even on floors. Nurses and other staff of the hospital said they sometimes have to overdo work to fulfil patient-care.

Asked what sort of problems the doctors were facing, a doctor on the hospital lobby said, "In place of ten minutes on an average, we can hardly allow more than five minutes to see each patient during regular inspec-

He added, 'The load of seeing extra patients is tremendously hampering treatment facility here. Patients complain of not paying proper attention to them but what can we do. We have to complete seeing all the admitted patients as per routine work by any means."

The crisis can only be overcome if the government strengthens the existing cardiovascular departments at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital, IPGMR and Mitford Hospi-

Patients suffering from heart ailment across the country rush to NICVD for treat ment. But had the hospitals, names of which are mentioned above, been properly equipped patients would not come and crowd at NICVD.

The NICVD authority said, There are many instances when we have to accept referred patients from DMCH or Mitford hospital who need ordinary treatment. There should be an end to this sort of burden to relieve our stress."

Meanwhile, a new building adjacent to NICVD premises, having a capacity of 400 beds would be ready for heart patients by June next year.

# 1176 industries identified for degradation of environment'

Environment and Forest Minister Sayeda Sajeda Chowdhury yesterday told par-liament that the Environment Department has identified 1176 industries in different sectors for degradation of environment and pollution of air, reports

Replying to a question from Kazi Sekandar Ali (AL-Khulna) the Minister said 351 textile industries, 140 tannery industries, two paper mills, four fertilizer factories, 17 plastic factories, 86 chemical industries, 43 pharmaceuticals, three food industries, nine sugar mills, 39 engineering firms, one distilleries, one refinery and 24 other industries under Dhaka division are responsible for degradation of environment and pollution of air.

She said of the remaining 452 industries responsible for degradation of environment and pollution of air, 188 are in Chittagong, 203 in Khulna and 66 in Rajshahi Divisions.

#### Rehabilitation of tribal refugees to be completed by Feb. '99'

RANGAMATI, June 18: The rehabilitation of the repatriated tribal refugees will be completed by February 1999 in accordance with the package of incentive committed by the government, reports BSS.

Talking to BSS, chairman of the Task Force on Tribal Refugees Rehabilitation Affairs, Dipankar Talukdar MP said here today that rehabilitation of those who had taken refuge internally due to insurgency will start soon after the rehabilitation of the repatriated refugees.

A meeting will be held at Khagrachhari on June 27 to monitor the rehabilitation process of the tribal refugees. Shakawat Hussain, Divisional Commissioner of Chittagong division is the member-secretary of the Task Force on Tribal Refugee Rehabilitation Affairs.

He further added that since he was busy with personal mat ters after submission of project application, and since he realised at one stage that it was not possible for him to run the cold storage by commuting to Mirzapur from Dhaka, he had decided in consultation with other directors not to implement the project.

"Because of this decision, I had informed Sonali Bank in writing about our unwillingness to implement the project and demanded back the submitted documents," Amin said.

He said he had no bad inten tion in the said business and that SB had not issued any loan sanction letter for Lunic Cold Storage. He also said he had informed the bank about his unwillingness about the project much before any investigation about the project.

He said if any irregularities had occurred in submitting documents by Naser Ahmed, the responsibility to detect those lies with the bank.

Our Reply: The Daily Star report was based on a BB investigation report as mentioned in the story. The question is how can the bank agree in principle to provide loan to a company without checking the bonafide of the entrepreneurs and the proposed assets.

The Daily Star had carried Sajjad Amin's versions yesterday. However, the investigation report said, "As the matter of forgery was revealed before disbursement of the loan, the managing director of the project had demanded back all the documents submitted with the loan application."
