


BUET Term 2 classes will resume today

Home Minister tells JS

Truck-timing for entry into city to be maintained

Home Minister Rafiqul Islam vesterday assured in Parliament that the timing for entrance of trucks in the city, par-ticularly in old Dhaka, will be maintained to ease the traffic

jam, reports UNB. The traffic police is being asked to strictly prohibit movement of trucks in the city during the peak hours, the minister said in response to a call notice moved by Hajee Mohammad Selim (AH).
Rafig admitted that terrible

traffic jams in the city have been causing untold sufferings to the city dwellers. He said a committee has been formed with Alhaj Maqbul Hossain MP as chairman to

suggest measures for easing the

chaotic traffic problem. The minister said the timing for the movement of loaded trucks in the city will be fixed shortly on the basis of the committee's recommendations.

The traffic situation in the capital has worsened in the absence of pragmatic steps in the past, he said, adding that although the city was being ex-

panded, no new roads constructed.

Rafiq said roads in Dhaka city constitute about 10 per cent of the area. This is quite inadequate compared with the standard 25 per cent. But there is no place to construct or expand the

roads in the city. The minister said some steps will be taken soon to ease the situation. But it will take at least 18 months more to overcome the traffic jam by con-structing fly-over and by-pass

The Dhaka City Corporation has been requested to bring about necessary changes to the traffic engineering aspects, he added.

In his notice, Hajee Mohammad Selim said the traffic jam in old Dhaka City became unbearable. Movement of trucks all the time has been obstructing the passage other vehicles including ambulance carrying serious patients to

He urged the Home Minister to fix a time schedule for movement of trucks.


