Losers outnumber gainers

Week's trading at the Dhaka Stock Exchange began with a fall in price index today as the losers outnumbered the gainers, reports UNB. The All Share Price Index at the country's main bourse dropped by 3.72 points or 0.78 per cent to 671.72 points from Wednesday's 677.05 points. Shares of 118 listed securities were transacted, of which 21 gained, 95 incurred loss and two remained unchanged. Some 254,229 shares and debentures valued at Tk 2.39 crore changed hands as against 415,675 shares worth Tk 4.19 crore on the previous trading day. Beximco Pharma (42,050), Chic Tex (35,000), Quasem Drycells (32,500), Rose Heaven Ball Pen (23,500) and Shine Pukur Holdings (12,900) were among the volume leaders.

Leading Euro bourses lose ground

LONDON, June 20: Leading European share markets all lost ground yesterday as London issues gave up 1.10 per cent, the Paris bourse 0.62 per cent, and Frankfurt stocks 0.27 per cent, reports AFP. London stocks came a cropper on fears of a near-term rise in British interest rates following recent signs of inflationary pressures in the UK economy. The Footsie index gave up 64 points or 1.10 per cent on the day to end at 5,748.1 points. Share prices were more or less breaking even for the majority of the session, but a negative trend on Wall Street pushed London down late in the day. Traders said price changes were exaggerated by the market's narrowness in the absence of any important news able to inspire investors. Share volume came to 750 million. The Paris bourse closed out the trading week with a substantial loss on Friday as the CAC 40 index finished at 4,027.32 points, down 0.62 per cent from the Thursday close. Operators said the market had spent the bulk of the day in the plus column, but many investors then preferred to close out their positions ahead of a G-7 meeting on Saturday in Tokyo. Paris share volume came to 11.6 billion francs. Frankfurt stocks booked a moderate loss as the Dax index finished at 5,702.61 points, down 0.27 per cent from 5,718.06 at the official close on Thursday. Trading was quiet, and operators said it was dominated by triple expiration of options and futures.
