### Govt considering to create 10,000 posts of police officers, employees

The government is actively considering a proposal for creating about 10,000 posts of police officers and employees, reports UNB.

Home Minister Rafiqul Islam disclosed this in Parliament responding to Shamsur Rahman Sharif of Awami League during the question hour.

He said some 3,289 police officers and constables will be recruited during the coming fiscal year (1998-99).

Of them, 56 are ASPs, 227 Sub-Inspectors (male), 45 SIs (female), 391 Sergeants and 2570 Constables.

In reply to Hajji Mohammad Selim (AL), the Minister said the Dhaka Central Jail is spread over a land of 36.76 acres.

### 'Govt seeks to collect latest methodology to speed up privatisation programme'

Commerce and Industries Minister Tofael Ahmed yesterday said the government wants to collect the latest methodology for speeding up the privatisation programme and various forms of mixed venture projects, reports UNB.

He was talking to a two-member team of High Point Rendel (RPT), the renowned international capital management and engineering company based in UK, at his office yesterday.

RPT is the designer of the Bangabandhu Bridge and worked as consultant engineering contract of the 11th largest bridge in the world.

The minister referred to privatisation of a good number of state-owned enterprises (SOEs) and said "We attract foreign equity participation in some SOEs for modernisation, restructuring and productivity improvement."

He said the government are setting up power plants under Built Own and Operate (BOO) system and signed production sharing contracts with foreign companies for the exploration and production of gas and oil.

The Commerce Minister said the government is interested in making joint-venture downstream projects in the gas sector.

"We are planning to restructuring the Karnafuli Fertiliser Company (KAFCO) and Chittagong Still Mills," said Tofael seeking RPT's support and service for early implementation of the projects.

Offering wide-range of support, the Chief Executive office of RPT, IW Reeves said the company has vast experience in giving consultation service and financing various projects in oil and gas, water resources, tourism and service sectors.

Highlighting RPT's involvement in the UNCTAD sponsored various development projects under BOO and BOT systems, Reeves showed keen interest in participating in the privatisation process of SOEs of Bangladesh.

RPT also organises fund for mixed ventures, he added.

The Commerce Minister thanked the Chief Executive Officer for their relentless efforts to the construction of the Bangabandhu Bridge and future planning to contribute in the economic activities of Bangladesh.

Answering a written question from Awami League member Fazlur Rahman Khan (Netrokona) the Foreign Minister said that Bangladesh missions had land properties in seven cities abroad. They are residence of the Bangladesh Ambassador at Washington, USA, chancery building and ambassador's residence in Ottawa, Canada, chancery building in Brussels, Belgium, chancery building and the High Commissioner's residence in London, UK, chancery building and the High Commissioner's residence in Pretoria, South Africa, chancery building and the ambassador's residence in Beijing, China and chancery building and the Deputy High Commissioner's residence in Calcutta, India.
