281 uplift projects being implemented

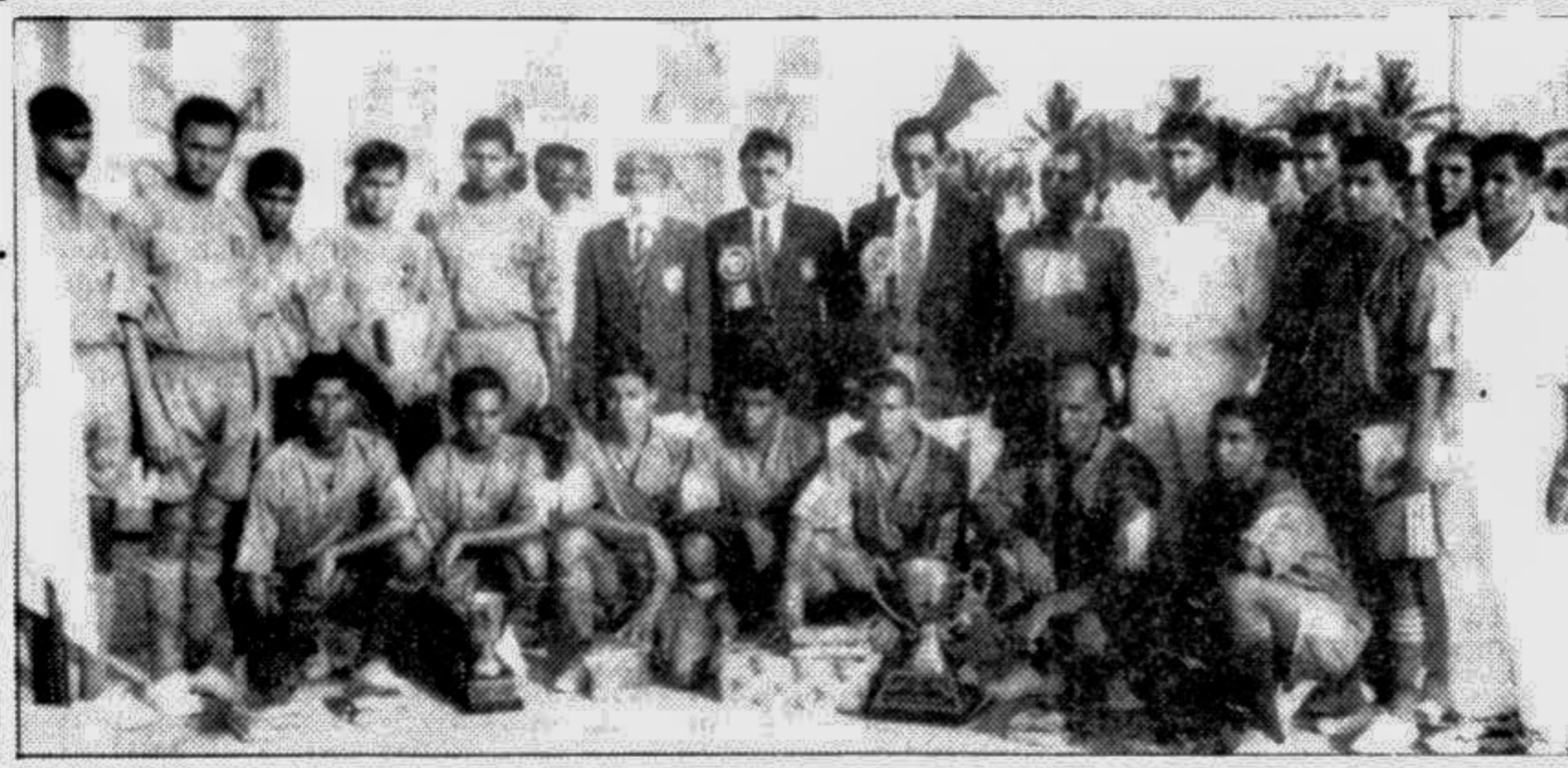

Fund shortage hampers repair work of Teesta Bridge

RANGPUR, June 26: Teesta Railway Bridge has turned unsafe for vehicular movement after a few months of repair work as its deck became loose endangering rail and road links between Kurigram-Lalmonirhat and rest of the country, reports UNB.

The cost of replacing old slippers was estimated by the Railway authorities at Taka one crore, but the Roads and Highways authorities sanctioned only Tk 30 lakh for the purpose.

The one-km long bridge was constructed on the river Teesta in Kaunia to establish direct rail link between Lalmonirhat-Kurigram and rest of the country during the British rule.
