Civil Surgeon's office ransacked

JESSORE. July 8: The Civil Surgeon's office here was ransacked by a group of agitated job seekers on Sunday, reports

The attack followed the publication of a list of successful candidates for appointment in several posts of the office. Sources said there is allegation that a number of candidates bribed some people for getting the jobs, but some of them had not been selected. Unsuccessful candidates attacked the office at about 9:30 am and ransacked it. They also exploded several hand-made bombs and damaged a jeep of a foreign agency at the office premises. A case has been lodged with the police.

SYLHET, July 8: Police have arrested two people on charges of murder and attack on police from Golapganj and Biswanath

Sadiqur Rahman Shabbir, a young businessman, was shot and injured by a group of armed men on June 29 and succumbed to his injuries at Bangabandhu Medical University Hospital in Dhaka. The other person was arrested on Thursday in Biswanath on charge of snatching away an accused and assaulting the police. The arrested, identified as Elkas Miah, 18, hails from village Nachni of the thana.

Teesta embankment reconstructed

RANGPUR, July 8: A major repair of the Teesta embankment, including 14-kilometre reconstruction, in Kaunia and Gangachara thanas, have been completed by Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) at a cost of Taka 36 lakh and 1,120 tonnes of wheat, official sources said, reports BSS.

The World Food Programme (WFP) provided wheat for "food for works" programme while the government allocated necessary funds. "Thousand acres have been saved from the threat of flood and river erosion with the completion of the work on the Teesta embankment," they added.

Three missing in boat capsize

SUNAMGANJ, July 8: Three people including a boatman have been missing as a boat capsized in the river Surma near Chhatak Bazar, reports UNB.

The missing men were identified as Matin. Ajmal and boatman Mochhabbir. Police said the boat left Chhatak Bazar for Barkapan with nine passengers on board at about 9 pm on June 29. But it capsized due to heavy current. Only six of the passengers managed to swim ashore.

Sugar mills exceeds output target

RANGPUR, July 8: The major sugar mills in the northern region have exceeded their targets of sugar production in the current season, the mill sources said, reports BSS.

Shaympur Sugar Mills produced 6,965 tonnes of sugar against its target of 5,320 tonnes, Joypurhat Sugar Mills produced 14,173 tonnes of sugar against the target of 11,400 tonnes. Panchagarh Sugar Mills produced 13,201 tonnes of sugar against its target of 11,700 tonnes and Thakurgaon Sugar Mills produced 14,583 tonnes of sugar against the target of 9,900

17000 hectares for jute cultivation

RANGPUR, July 8: About 17,000 hectares of land have been brought under jute cultivation in all the eight thanas of the dis-

Most rivers mark rise

Surma, Halda, Matamuhuri flowing above danger level

The Surma, Halda and Matamuhuri rivers were flowing above their respective danger levels, Flood Forecasting and Warning Centre of Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) sources said on

Tuesday, reports BSS. The Brahmaputra and the Ganges registered further rise at all points except at Chilmari while rivers in the Meghna and south eastern hill basins recorded both rise and fall.

The Surma at Kanaighat, the Halda at Narayanhat and the Matamuhuri at Chiringa have crossed the red mark.

Under the influence of active monsoon over Bangladesh. light to moderately heavy rainfall occurred at most places.

Significant rainfall recorded at different places area: 151.5 mm at Chandpur, 116 mm at Lama, 90.5 mm at Bogra, 81.1 mm at Dinajpur, 63.5 mm at Panchpukuria, 55 mm at Sunamganj, 48 mm at Parshuram, 43.2 mm at Kushtia, 36 mm at Bandarban, 35.5 mm at Sheola, 33.5 mm at Durgapur, 32.6 mm at Mymensingh and 30 mm at Jamalpur.

The Brahmaputra recorded further rise by 8 cm at Sirajganj. 12 cm at Aricha and slight rise at Noonkhawa and Bahadurabad while it remained steady at Chilmari. The river at Bahadurabad is flowing only 1

cm below danger level. The Dharla at Kurigram registered further rise by 10 cm. the Teesta recorded rise by 8 cm at Dalia and by 18 cm at Kau-

The old Brahmaputra registered further rise by 10 cm at Jamalpur and by 8 cm at Mymensingh.

The Buriganga at Dhaka and Lakhya at Narayanganj each recorded rise by 4 cm. The Turage also registered rise by 7 cm at Mirpur and by 5 cm at Tongi. The Kaliganga observed further rise by 9 cm at Taraghjat. All the rivers in the Brahmaputra basin, however, are flowing below their respective danger levels.

The Ganges registered further rise by 23 cm at Pankha, 18 cm at Rajshahi, 6 cm at Goalando and slight rise at Bhagyakul.

The Karatoa at Panchagarh marked further rise. The Punarbhaba marked sharp rise at Dinajpur. The Mohananda at Chapainawabganj registered further rise by 17 cm. The Gorai at Gorai railway bridge also registered further rise by 20 cm.
