Ban on hazardous family planning methods sought

Protirodh Network (PN), a resistance network against abuse of fertility controlling technology, has demanded an immediate ban on family planning methods which have been causing serious health hazards to women.
Urging the government to improve rural health services, the voluntary organisation fighting for women's rights also called for stopping indiscriminate trials of various poisonous drugs and harmful methods of birth control on women in the name of family planning programme.
PN leaders at a press conference held at the National Press Club in the city yesterday alleged that donors, multinational organisations and international drug companies have been imposing harmful family planning methods on Bangladesh and conducting trials on poor women.
The PN organised the briefing in advance of the World Population Day on July 11 to help create awareness among people about the abuse of harmful family planning methods.
Reading out a written statement at the briefing, PN leader Farida Akhter said, "We do not oppose family planning, but the harmful methods and experimentation of dangerous birth control systems on women's bodies must be stopped."
"We are planning to take legal action against the abuse of harmful family planning materials," said Akhter. She added that birth control methods including injectable Depo-Provera, Norplant and Quinacrin often cause serious health hazards.
She said women suffer from various physical complications including excessive bleeding, premature menopause, vertigo, loss of eyesight, fluid retention and general weakness by using such birth control materials.
The PN leaders suggested natural and herbal-oriented birth control methods for saving women from health hazards.
Among others, Natasha Ahmed, Prof Latifa Akhond and Sheema Da Shima of the organisation were present at the briefing.

The SAARC Women's Association (SAARCWA) has donated Taka 25,000 to the Shishu Hospital for a bed for poor sick children, says a press release.
President of the Association Sarwari Rahman handed over a cheque for the amount to Director of Shishu Hospital Prof Manzur Hussain in the city recently.
Among others, Zakia Doha, Roushan Ara Nuri, Zahida Isphani and Soniya Hussain were present on the occasion, the release said.
