BMSP survey reveals

59 incidents of acid throwing occurred April to June

It was a warm summer evening of late June when a family at Moktarpur village in Monirampur thana of Jessore district was taking their supper. reports UNB.

They never knew that a tragedy was awaiting them.

Angered by a land dispute, a group of their rivals threw acid through the window of their kitchen leaving a mother and her three sons — Kamrul, 20, Anwarul, 18, and Akhtarul, 7 seriously injured. They are now undergoing treatment at a local hospital.

None, except the victims, know how much pain they are carrying now and what the misery awaits them.

The family is no exception. Many people are falling victim to acid throwing throughout the country everyday. We can only know a few of them.

A survey of Bangladesh Manobadhikar Samonnoy Parishad (BMSP) revealed that 59 incidents of acid throwing occurred in the country from

It showed that the incident of acid throwing in the second quarter of the year is 103 per cent higher than that of the first quarter (January to

The report also disclosed that death over dowry in the second quarter is 366 per cent higher compared to the first quarter. When 12 such killings were recorded from January to March, a total of 56 deaths over dowry registered from April to

However, the number of killings by law enforcing agencies decreased from 13 to five in the second quarter. Of the five deaths, two each were killed by police and forest guards and one by Ansar.

Capital Dhaka topped the list in women killing during the period of April-June with 22 such reported murders. The total number of women killings in the country was 155 during the time in comparison to 106 in the first quarter, the report

Election of JUVC panel: Hectic lobbying on

Hectic lobbying is continuing among the teachers and senators of Jahangirnagar University (JU) for the July 11 election of a three-member "VC Panel" for appointment of a new Vice Chancellor of the university.

A total of 84 seniators out of the 93-member JU senate are expected to cast their votes in the polls scheduled tomorrow. Nine posts in the sienate are lying vacant due to various rea-

Two groups of JU teachers have nominated their candidates in the election.

The group backed by the present VC Prof /mirul Islam Chowdhury under the banner "Democratic-progressive" has nominated JU Treasurer and a reputed column st of The Daily Star and The Bhorer Kagoj Prof Abdul Bayes, Pr of Mesbahuddin Ahmed of Chemistry and JU pro-VC Prof Alauddin Ahmed.

The other group led by Prof Khondakar Mustahidur Rahman under the banner of "Sarbadalio Oikk ya Panel" has nominated Prof Abdul Awal of Chemistry Department Prof Abdul Ghani of Pharmacy Department and Prof Khondakar Mustahidur Rahman of Eco-

nomics Department. The "Democratic-Progressive" group is known to be dominated by pro-Awami League stalwarts while the "Sarbadalio Oikkya Panel" is led by pro-BNP teachers with other people having different political affillations.

President and Chancellor of the universities Justice shahabuddin Ahmed is expected to appoint the VC from the elected three-member panel by July 17 as the tenure of the present VC Prof Amirul Islam Chowdhury ends July 18.

The 93-member JU senate consists of 33 teachers' representatives. 25 registered graduates, 5 members from leading research organisations, 5 college principals, 5 MPs, 5 government officials, 5 eminent citizens, 5 student representatives, chairman of Dhaka Board, Divisional Commissioner of Dhaka, treasurer, pro-VC and the VC.


