

Italian opposition leader Berlusconi convicted in corruption case

MILAN, July 13: Silvio Berlusconi, the media baron and Italian opposition leader. was convicted Monday of corruption in yet another legal setback to the former premier, reports AP.

A Milan court sentenced him to two years, four months in prison for making illegal contributions in 1991 to the socialist party of ex-premier Bettino Craxi.

Last Wednesday, Berlusconi was convicted of bribing tax inspectors and sentenced to two years and nine months in prison. In December he was convicted in a case centering on a film company deal and given a suspended 16-month sen-

It was unlikely Berlusconi would serve the other sentences as most prison terms under three years for white collar crimes are later suspended.

Prosecutors alleged that Berlusconi and his associates funneled the illegal contributions to Craxi through a holding company called all Iberian, and that the books of Berluscon's businesses were doctored to cover up the outlay.

A trial on the false accounting charge was scheduled for September.

Investigators said the payments through All Iberian totaled 6.6 million dollars.

Craxi was a friend to Berlusconi during the go-go 1980s in Milan, and reportedly gave him political backing as Berlusconi built up his television empire into the only rival to the state broadcasting system.

Craxi was one of the most prominent of the once-powerful political figures brought down by the wave of corruption investigations starting in 1992 known as "Clean Hands," He has been convicted at least five

times for corruptions.

Democracywatch opinion poll shows

AL's popularity declines, BNP gains

An opinion poll yesterday revealed that the ruling party's popularity has decreased in the last two years while the opposition BNP has gained popularity during the period.

The Social Survey unit of Democracywatch conducted the opinion poll on "People's Verdict on Awami League Government's Two Years in Power" on the occasion of AL's completion of two years in power.

The poll was conducted during the period of June 17-27 and a total of 2820 persons were inerviewed.

Compared to the 1996 election results, BNP's popularity has increased by 6 per cent while AL's has decreased by 4 per cent, the poll results

Considering all aspects, 50 per cent respondents said that they were not satisfied with the AL government's performance while 41 per cent expressed their satisfaction. Nine per cent did not reply

Replying to the question — if a general election is held tomorrow, whom would you vote for - thirty-nine per cent said, 'BNP' while 33 per cent are in favour of AL. Twenty per cent will vote for Jatiya Party and five per cent preferred Jamaate-Islami.

RANGAMATI, July 13: Kaptai Lake Fisheries Development and Marketing Project (KLFDMP) has earned a revenue of Tk 2.75 crore by extracting 6,500 metric tons of fish from the lake in the last fiscal, reports BSS.

Highest since the project's creation in 1961, the earning was made possible as peace has been restored in the Chittagong Hill Tracts following the signing of the peace accord. A project of Bangladesh
