11,905 hectares of fallow and illegally occupied lands.

Tree would be planted along 25,000 km of roads, highways and railway tracks.

The target to plant trees along the roads and railway tracks calls for participation of the people as part of the social forestry programme, emphasizing on fruit trees, she added.

The plan calls for planting fruit trees on both sides of the railway tracks. That will provide income and nutrition to the people, and maintain biodiversity," she said.

About the government's programme to create plantations on the government-owned lands and fallow lands along with shelters for the poor, she said it would help stem migration to the city and urban centres from rural areas.

The Minister said the plan also outlines a new strategy to use the demarcation lines between the crop fields by planting trees, specially palm, dates, betel nuts and acacia. The programme in this regard has already been started.

Sajeda Choudhury said the other targets of the plan calls for developing 708 hectares of new forests on char lands, 12,000 hectares of unclassified lands to help slash-and-burn farmers at Bandarban and rehabilitate vanishing shal forests on 40,000 hectares in CHT, Mymensingh and Sylhet.

The plan also calls for developing 31,408 hectares of industrial forests to beef up the existing 11,223 hectares. The NGOs would contribute to the creation of 400 hectares of industrial forest.

A wildlife sanctuary will be developed at Dulahazara in Cox's Bazar and 43,400 hectares of forests will be rehabilitated at the National Park. Another sanctuary will be developed in Khulna Division.

Production Sharing Contract (PSC) signed with Cairn, the government must purchase the gas or ensure a way to sell it.

Petrobangla is now buying Sangu gas by reducing production in other gas fields where the production cost is less than half of Sangu gas, the sources said.

With a proven reserve of 880 billion cubic feet of gas, the Sangu field would ultimately provide 160 mcm/d gas.

Meanwhile, the sources pointed out that Petrobangla's monitoring of the Sangu field, which is owned by Bangladesh, is almost absent.

The Sundarbans, which was declared a world heritage site by Unesco last year, bears testimony to the government's resolve to protect the environment, the minister said, adding that there is a plan to develop mangrove forests on 26,908 hectares of land and maintain another 10,244 hectares of mangrove forests on the coast.

On the coastal green-belt project, the minister said it will be completed in the year 2000, costing Tk 124 crore. Started in 1995, the project is being funded by the Asian Development Bank and the Norwegian Development Agency.

The project ensures participation of the people, NGOs and various government departments. It includes planting trees along the coast, roads and highways, embankments, homesteads and government institutions in 12 coastal districts.

Designed to protect the coastal districts from cyclones and sea surges, the massive programme envisages economic upliftment in the coastal belts and providing income to rural people, particularly women through social forestry combining fruit, coconut and mangrove, she added.

She said that the mangrove plantation at Patenga in Chittagong is facing problems due to the activities of the ship-breakers. They have caused environmental damage on at least an 8 km strip of the coast with oil, iron scraps and other effluents.

"We are going to notify them to develop a dry dock instead of breaking ships indiscriminately on the sea shore," she added.

The ships and oil tankers discharging bilge at the Cox's Bazar coast are also affecting the beach, which calls for cleaning the coast to make them attractive to the tourists, the minister said.

fish by 13.42 per cent. It said prices of flour and soap were stable during the period while those of pulses fell by 4.42 per cent.

CAB said there has been no system of quality control, proper weight maintenance and fair prices fixation in the economy and that the stores are marketing their products whimsically.

It said the government is not taking any effective measures against frequent price hikes. CAB has expressed concern over the frequent currency devaluation.

It said that service charges for education, healthcare, transportation and house rent are also increasing along with the prices of essentials.

The association suggested that the government should strengthen its market-monitoring system and take legal actions against dishonest traders.
