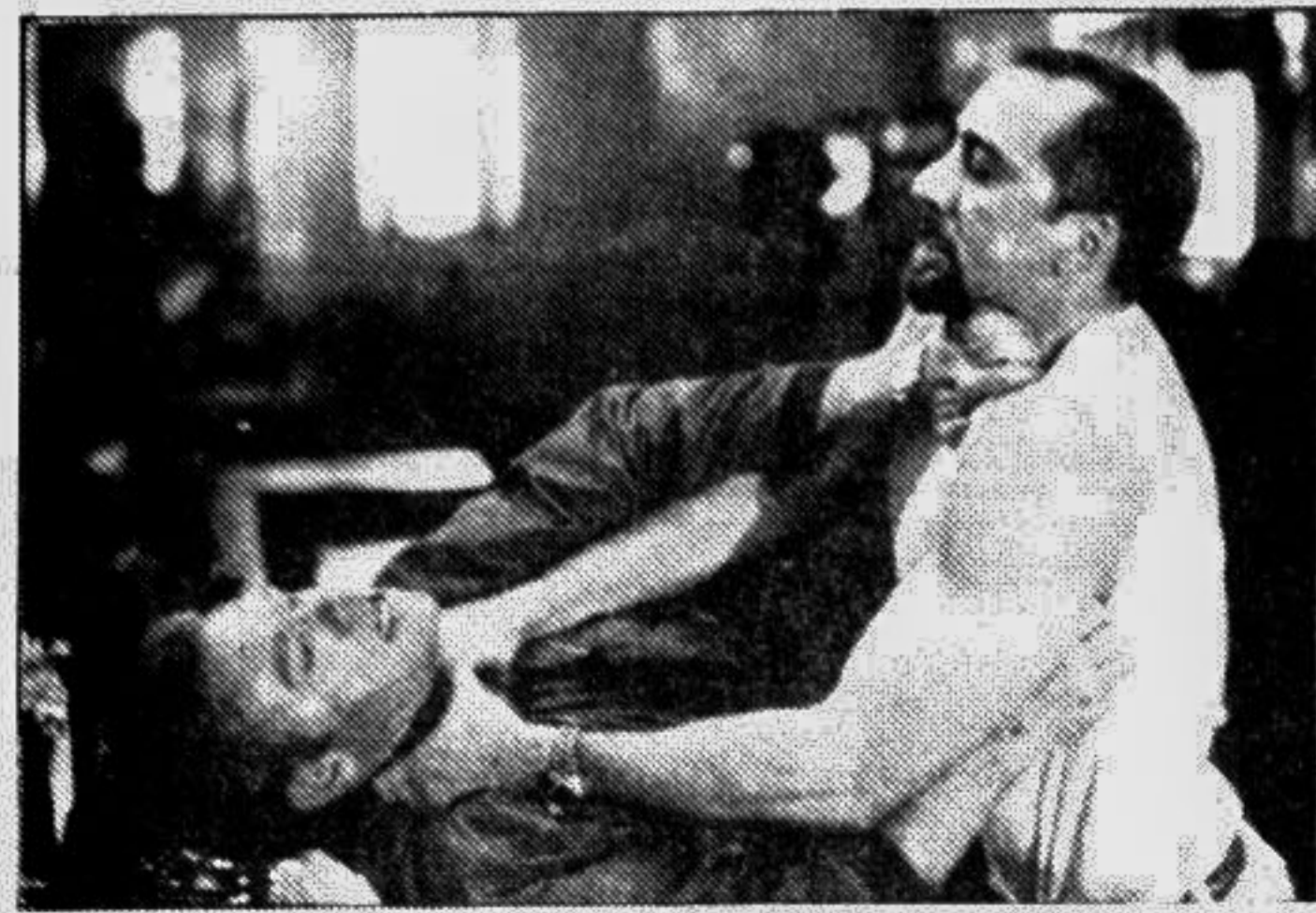


The Show

July 22nd at 10:00 PM on Star Movies

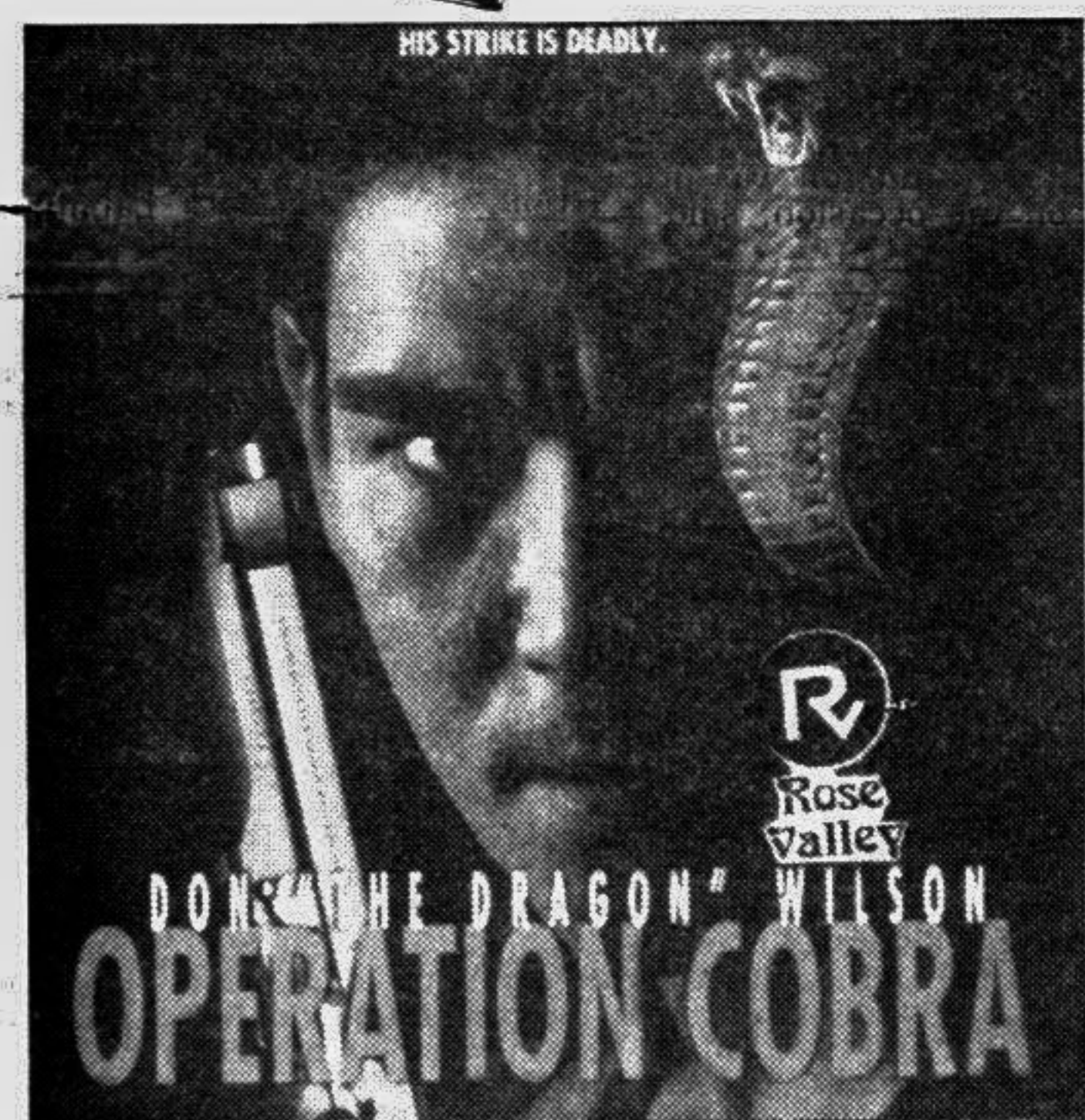

THE TROIKA IN USA

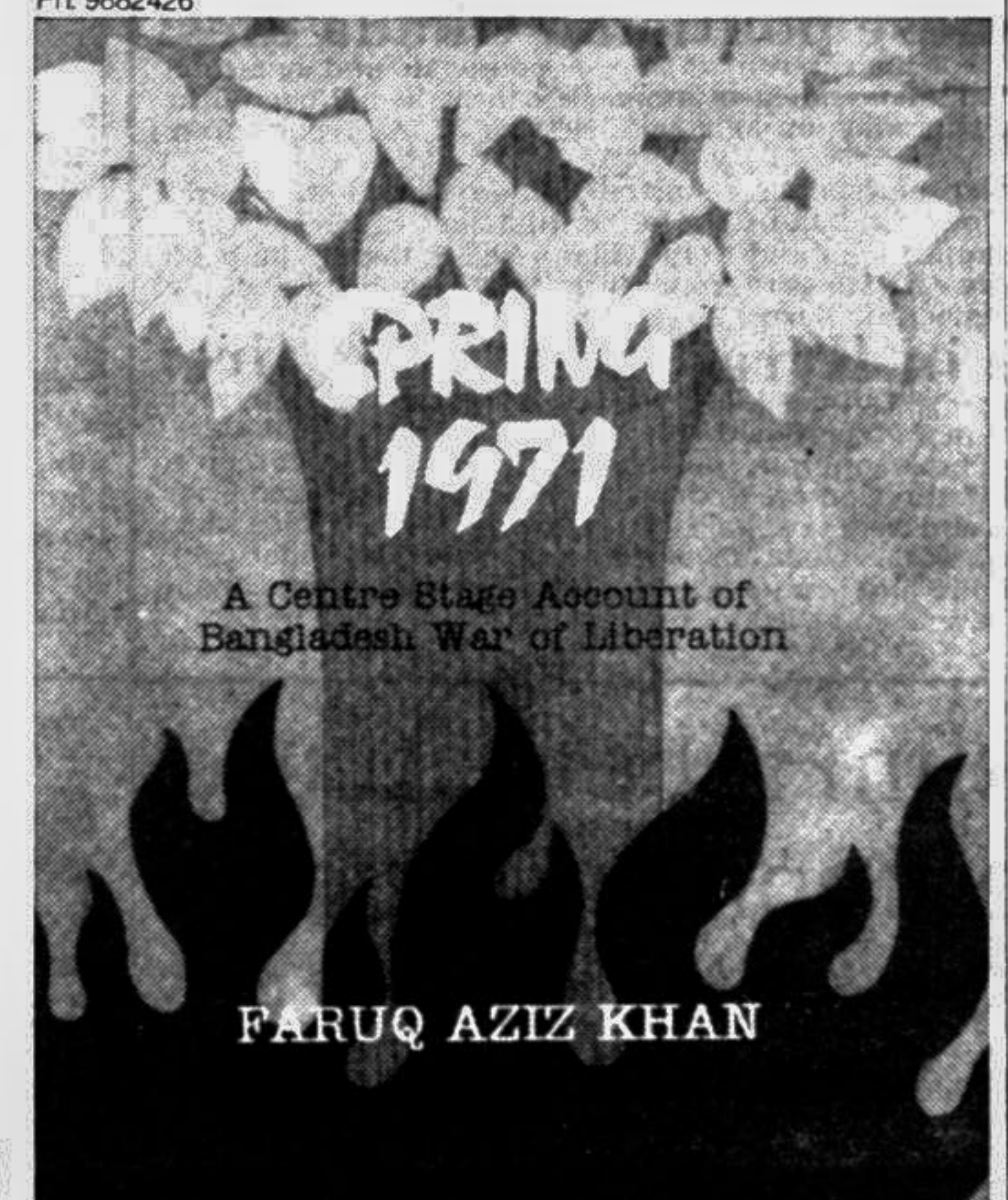

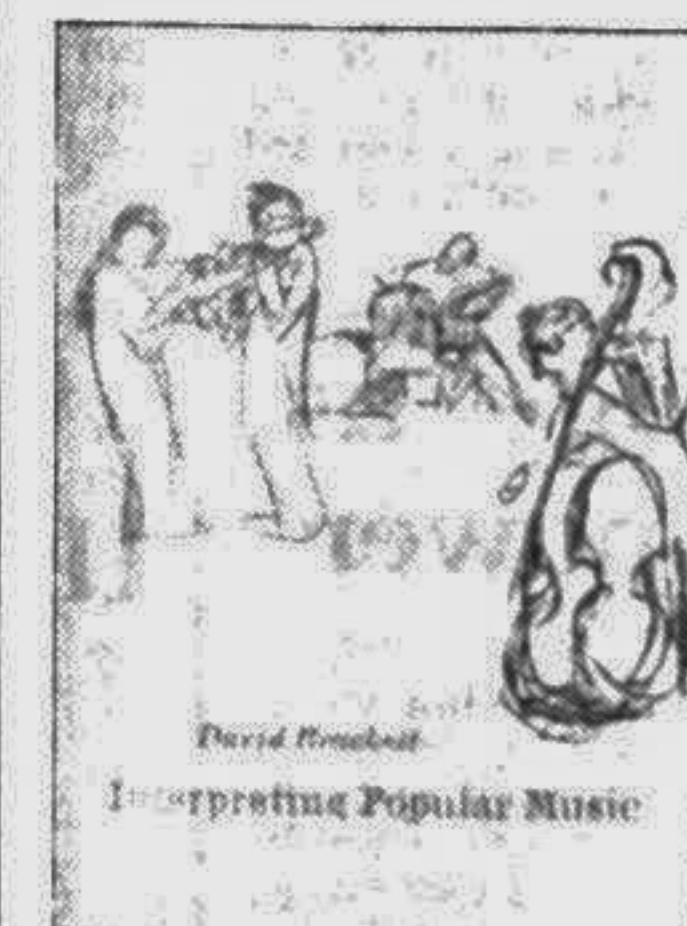

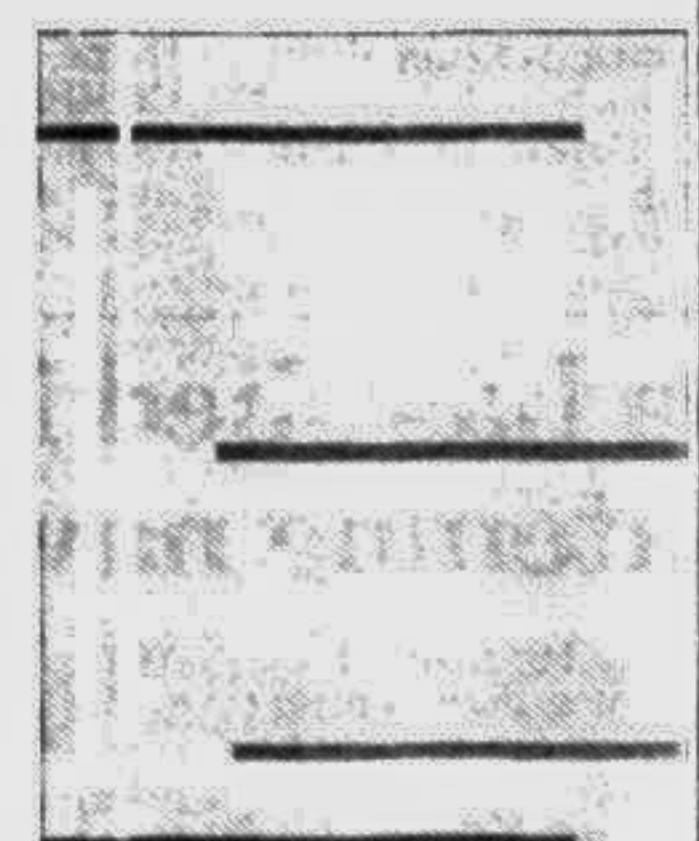
