Jamaat's fresh agitation programme announced

Jamaat-e-Islami yesterday announced a fresh agitation programme to protest the alleged attack on its central office during the hartal hours on Thursday, reports UNB.

The programme includes demonstration at all the divisional headquarters except Barisal today and observance of 'protest day' at all the district headquarters on Sunday.

The agitation programme was announced at a press conference at the National Press Club this (Friday) afternoon.

Addressing the press conference, Jamaat's assistant secretary general Mohammad Kamruzzaman accused the government of instituting a police rule in the country unleashing repression on the opposition leaders and activists.

'Safety and security of the people will not be there if the government itself creates terrorism in society by using police and if thanas don't take cases,' he said.

Reading out a written statement on behalf of Jamaat Nayeb-e-Ameer Moulana Abul Kalam Mohammad Yousuf, he alleged that an Awami League procession attacked its central office and the offices of daily Sangram at Maghbaraz on Thursday.
