Rampant hill-cutting blamed Low-lying areas of Ctg face water-logging

CHITTAGONG, Aug 2: Most low-lying areas of the port city face water-logging during monsoon rains every year. Consequently, hundreds of thousands of people in the low-lying areas suffer the worst as they are virtually held hostage by water-logging, while traffic movements come to a halt, local residents said.

But the city authorities are yet to frame any definite strategy to combat the problem.

The areas mostly affected include Chawkbazar, Sholakbazar, Katalgonj, Bakalia, Badurtola, Chandga, Babubazar, Bahaddarhat, Muradpur, Nasirabad, Chaktai, Kha-

tungonj, Chaulpatti, Rajakali and GEC crossing, according to local sources.

City corporation officials here attributed the water-logging to washed down mud and sand following rampant cutting of hills dotting the city, which continues unabated despite protests from various quarters.

The top soil from the hills flows down with rain water and causes siltation in the drainage system, blocking all outlets for water during rainfall, they said.

The officials opined that the water-logging problem would not be resolved until the practice of cutting hills for soil procurement is stopped permanently.

Effective action plan needed to develop smaller enterprises

Speakers at a workshop yesterday emphasised the need for formulating an effective and forward-looking action plan for creating jobs through development of small and medium enterprises across the country, reports ESS.

They were addressing a workshop on "Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) sub-sectors organised by Job Opportunities and Business Support (JOBS) funded by USAID at a hotel here.

US acting director Dr David Sprague, JOBS representative Dr Zia U Ahmed, Bangladesh Economic Association vice president Prof Mamtazuddin Ahmed, Bangladesh Employers Association president Rokia Rahman, ADAB chairperson Dr Qazi Faruque Ahmed, economists Dr Zaid Bakht and Dr Zahurul Alam also addressed the workshop.

Dr Sprague said creating self-employment is the best option for Bangladesh to end poverty. Empowering the poor and ensuring food security through micro enterprises can be the engine of growth for Bangladesh, which, he said, has to go a long way in creating job opportunities.

Presenting the key findings of the study of eight SME sub-sectors in Bangladesh, Dr Mamtazuddin said Bangladesh has to formulate a comprehensive policy and plan for the development of micro and medium enterprises.

Rokia Rahman, president of Bangladesh Employers Association, said small and medium enterprises have become the worst victims of disruptions in the power supply and other infrastructural support. She also said that due to inconsistencies in government policies, there has been a shift of labour from the rural to urban areas.

GCO submits memo to UGC

The GCO organised a protest march towards the office of the UGC at about 11 am from Modhu's Canteen as the part of their gherao programme announced earlier.

The GCO march, which was intercepted by police at Shahbagh area, held a rally there. The rally was addressed among others by Sharfuzzaman Sharif, Shahidul Islam Shahid and Ashraf Sebu.

A delegation of the GCO later submitted the memorandum to the UGC.

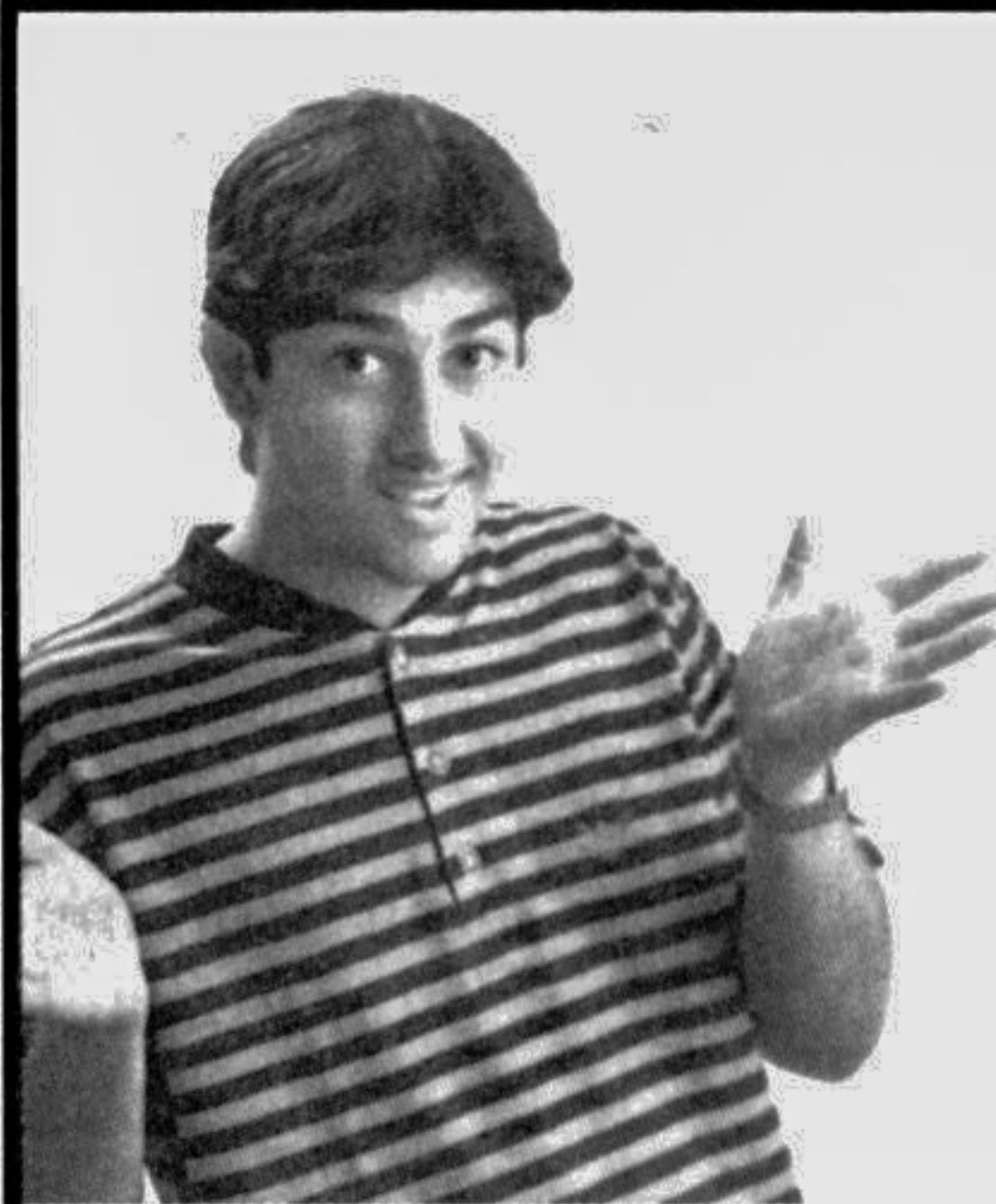
