**Charity show to collect money for flood victims today**

To help the flood hit people of the country, the Bangladesh Rabindrasangeet Shilpee Sangsod (BRSS) will organise a cultural function on Tagore's songs today in the evening.

The programme which will also celebrate Shrabani 22, will be held at the Central Public Library auditorium at Shahbagh.

The money to be collected from the show would be donated among the flood affected people, said a press release signed by Tapan Mahmud, secretary general of the BRSS.

**Report on major crime incidents published**

Tadanta Prakashana, a detailed investigative report on major crime incidents in the country, has been published, reports UNB.

The publication contains 71 reports on various crimes, including rape, repression on women and children, and their trafficking, during the first six months of this year.

The report, published by Bangladesh Society for Enforcement of Human Rights, was launched at a press briefing at the Jatiya Press Club yesterday.

Justice Kemaluddin Hossain was the chief guest, while Press Club president Reazuddin Ahmed, BSEHR secretary general advocate Sigma Huda and advocate Alina Khan addressed the briefing.

The report also contains recommendations made by the investigators to overcome the difficulties faced by crime victims in filing complaints and the human rights activists in conducting investigations.

**Jalalabad Assoc team meets Anwar**

An 11-member delegation of Jalalabad Association, led by its president Dr. Ayubur Rahman yesterday called on Communications minister Anwar Hossain at his secretariat office.


