interest groups in the past. He described the Liberation War as the greatest glorious event in our history of thousand years through which the Bangalees emerged as a nation under the leadership of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

National Museum can play an important role in preserving the glorious past of the nation to provide guidelines for us to help build a prosperous country, he added.

State Minister Obaidul Quader, in his speech, said the government is committed to restoring the reputation of the national museum.

The government is trying to enrich the museum with rare collections, he added.

Later, Kibria inaugurated the exhibition.

**Prof Syed Ali Ashraf dead**

Prof Syed Ali Ashraf, the founder Vice-Chancellor of Darul Ihsan University, died at his Cambridge residence in the UK on Thursday. He was 74, said a press release.

His body is scheduled to arrive in Dhaka on Monday morning.

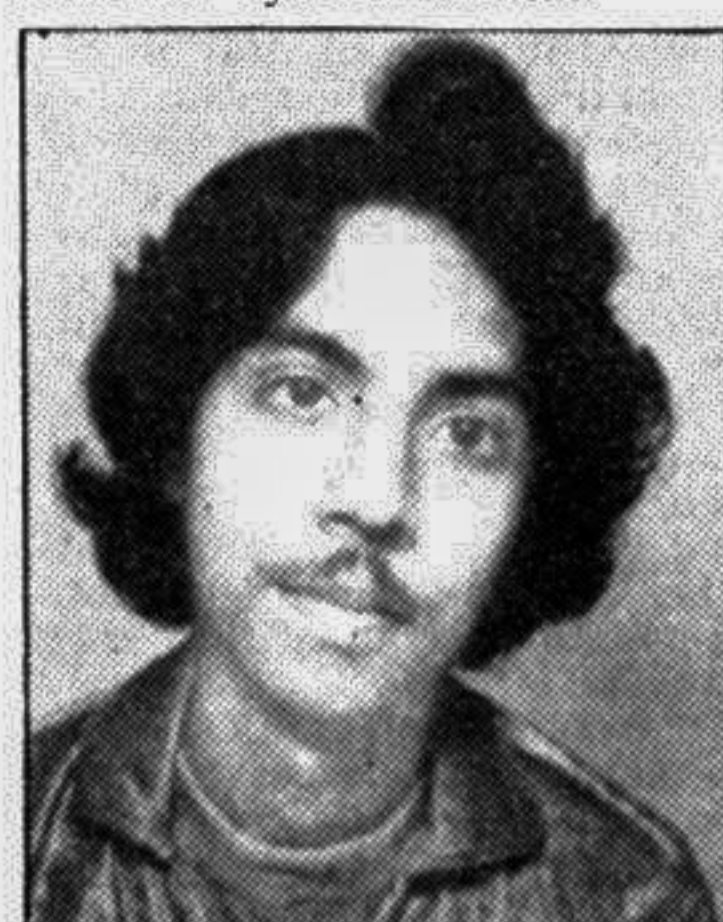
Born in 1924, Syed Ali Ashraf joined the Dhaka University as a lecturer in the Department of English. From 1956 to 93, he was the Head of the English Department of the Karachi University.

Prof Ashraf was also the Head of the Department of English in the King Abdul Aziz University in Jeddah from 1974 to 1984.

Prof Ashraf became the first director of the World Centre for Islamic Education Conference, established by the OIC. He served there as the director from 1980 to 1982.

A member of the Faculty of Education at the Cambridge University, he was a visiting professor at the same university. He was also the editor of the Muslim Education Quarterly, published by the Islamic Academy in Cambridge.

Prof Ashraf has left behind his wife and a host of relatives and admirers. He was the younger brother of National Professor Syed Ali Ahsan.



**Death anniversary of Bapi Shahriar today**

The 9th death anniversary of young rhyme composer Bapi Shahriar will be observed today, says a press release.

As part of the observance, member of his family will place wreaths at his grave in Banani in the morning. The patients of the Paralysis Ward at the Ortophedic Hospital in Sher-e-Bangla Nagar will also be served special.

Shahriar received serious injuries in a car accident in 1985 and died on August 8, 1989 after four years of treatment.

**Tk 8.12 cr earmarked for agri rehabilitation**

KISHOREGANJ, Aug 7: Minister for LGRD and Cooperatives Zilur Rahman today said the government has taken up necessary steps for implementation of a massive post-flood rehabilitation programme to help the flood affected people of the country, reports BSS.

He was addressing a public rally at Kuliarchar thana under the district while distributing relief goods among the flood stricken people there, an official handout said.

The relief work was conducted on behalf of Bangladesh Awami League which distributed rice, pulse, cash money, saline, dry food, water purifying tablets and other relief goods among the flood victims.

The LGRD and Cooperatives Minister said the government had already earmarked an amount of Taka 8.12 crore for agricultural rehabilitation as soon as flood water recedes from the affected areas. A special housing rehabilitation programme will also be undertaken for the families affected by river erosion during the flood, he said.

Besides, the minister said, the government has decided to expand the vulnerable group

feeding (VGF) programme among the poor people after the flood.

The minister said some quarters were now out to spread untrue statements to confuse the people despite the government's sincere and proper relief activities among the flood stricken people in the country.

He called upon the opposition parties not to do politics with the lot of the flood affected people of the country.
