Death of Musa CHT All Party Council demands punishment of policemen

All Party Unity Council of Chittagong Hill Tracts yesterday demanded immediate punishment of the policemen responsible for the killing of Musa and compensation for his family, reports UNB.

Addressing a press conference at Jatiya Press Club, the council leaders alleged that CHT leader Musa died Wednesday following torture in police custody after being arrested on May 28.

Former MP and leader of the council Wadud Bhuiyan read out a statement at the press conference.

Musa's wife Sajeda Begum, her brother Jaymal Abedin, advocates Elina Khan and Mujibul Haq from a human rights organisation also attended the press conference.

In his statement, Wadud Bhuiyan said ASIS of Ramgharh thana Mujibar Rahman and Noor Mohammad Khan picked up Musa from his house on May 28. He alleged that the policemen tortured Musa in Ramgharh thana overnight and filed a false case against him the following day.

Bhuiyan said Musa was admitted to Khagachhari Adhunik Hospital and then shifted to Chittagong Medical College Hospital. But the policemen tortured him again after he recovered slightly and the process continued until he was sent to Dhaka Central Jail on August 3, he added.
