THE JUNGLE BOOK

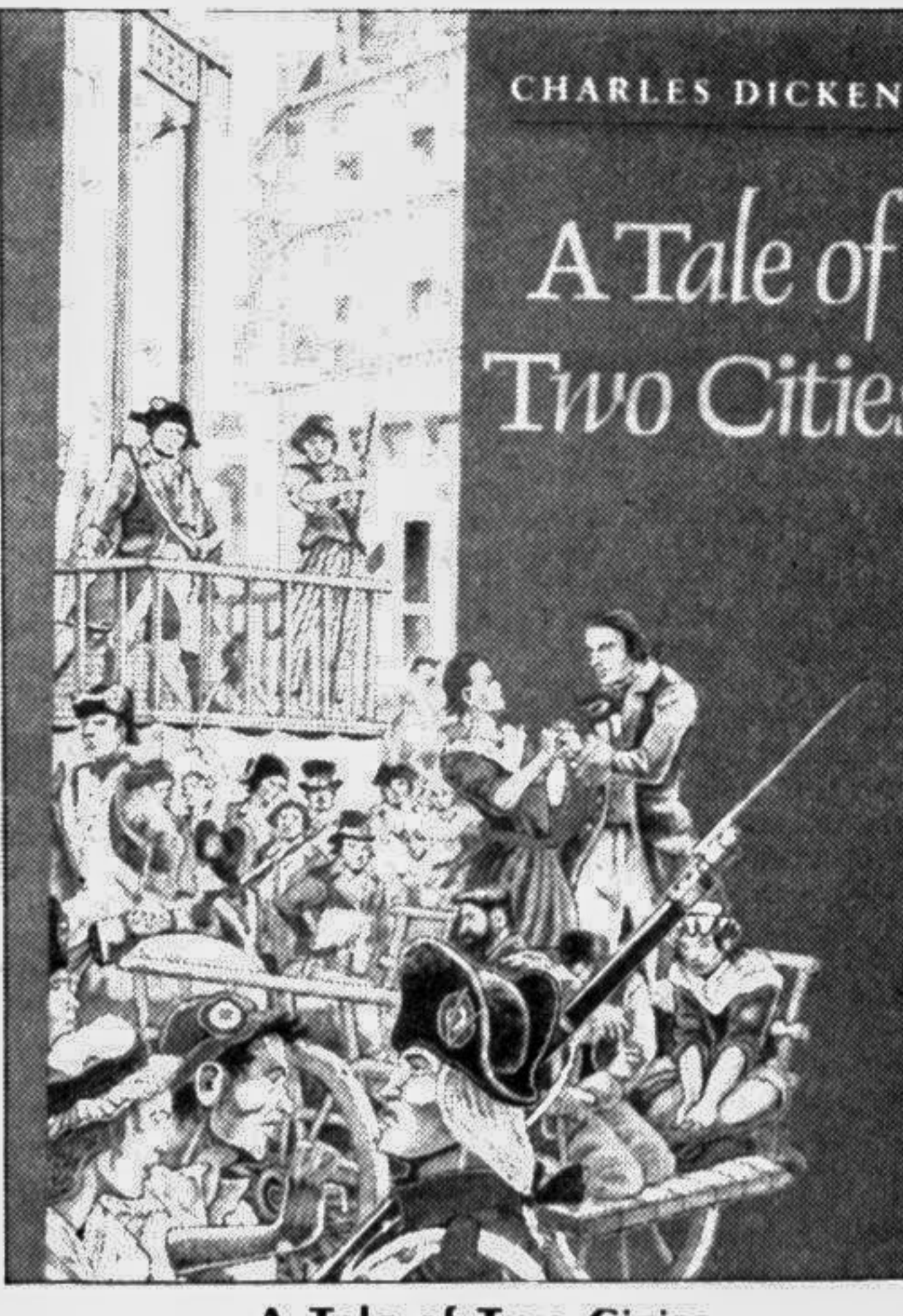

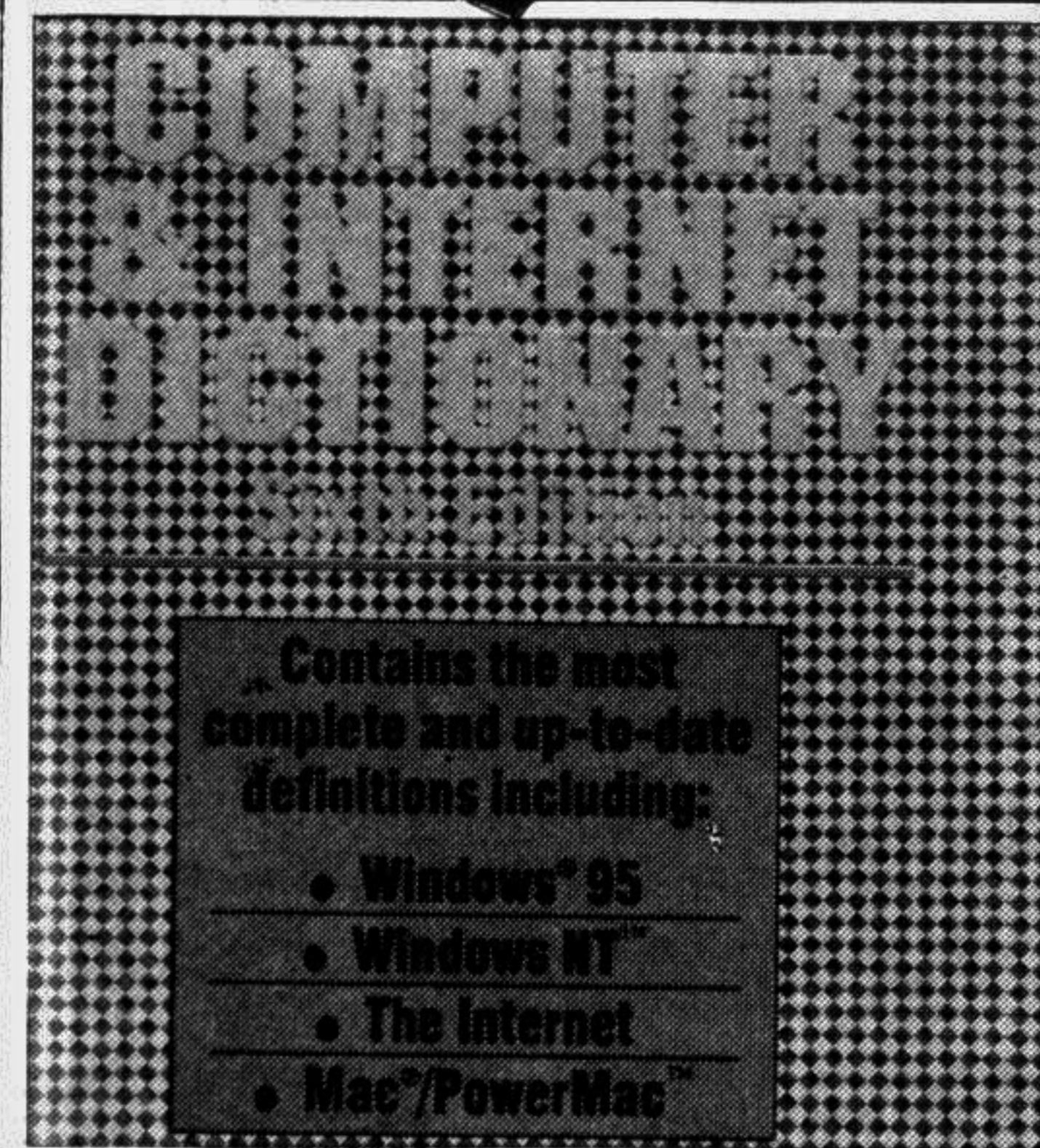

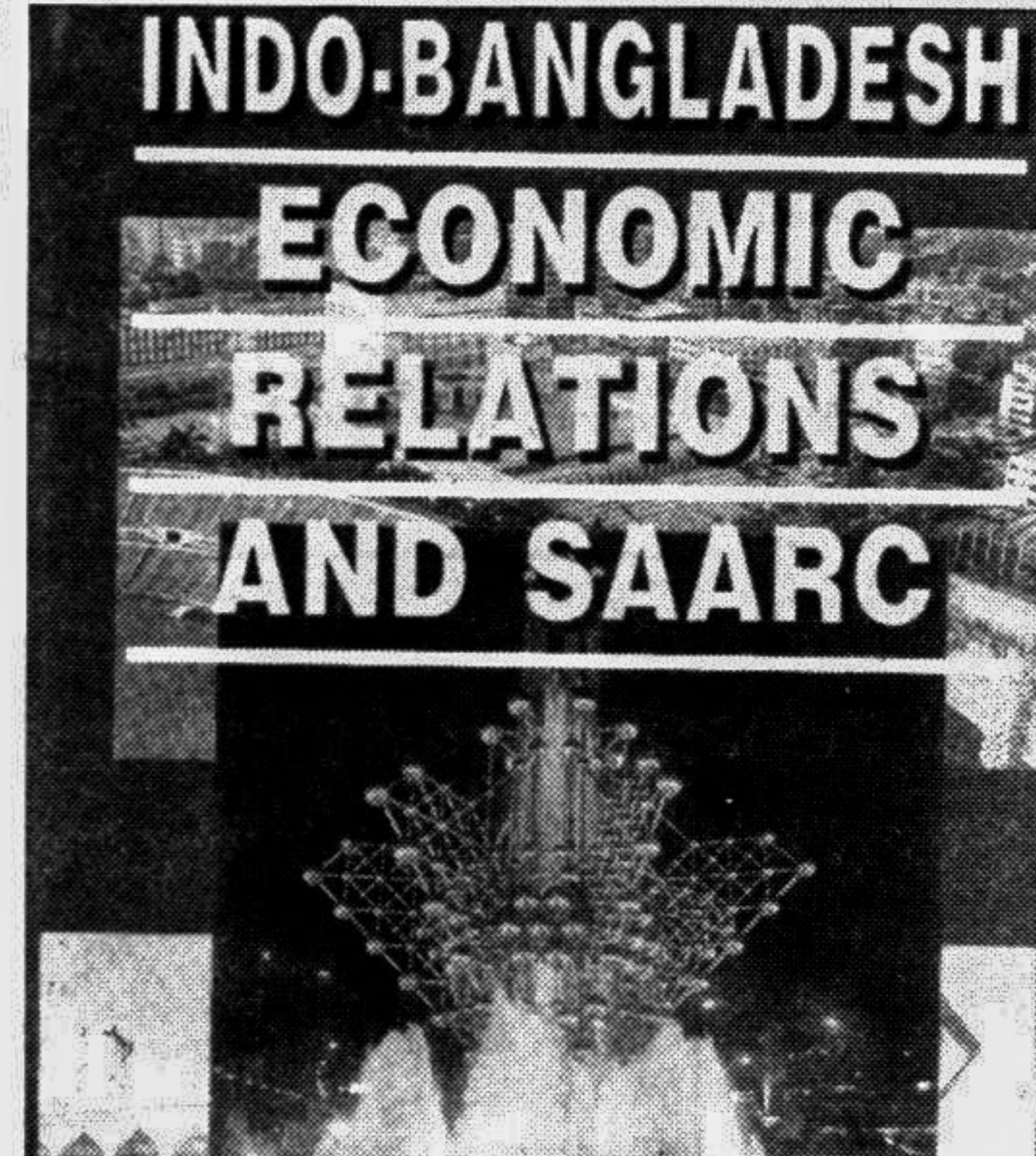
