Judicial probe into Baburabad killing demanded

Nadi Shikasti Gono Adhikar Forum (NASHGAF), a forum for the rights of river erosion affected people, has demanded a judicial inquiry into the Baburabad killing in Satkhira.

"The conspiracy has been further extended to evict landless settlers from their homesteads through police violence leaving one woman and three children dead."

"It is a shame for the government and the nascent democracy of Bangladesh," the release said.
