**PM makes spl allocation of Tk 57 lakh for flood victims**

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday made a special allocation of Taka 57 lakh from her relief and welfare fund to distribute among the flood-affected people of 37 districts of the country, reports BSS.

This allocation is in addition to the money sanctioned for the flood-hit people regularly from the Ministry of Relief and Disaster Management as well as Prime Minister's Relief Fund.

Steps have already been taken to send the aforesaid special allocated money to the respective Deputy Commissioners through wire services to ensure speedy distribution of money

among the flood-hit people. Of the amount the districts of Dhaka, Narsingdi, Narayanganj, Faridpur, Manikganj, Rajbari, Munshiganj, Jamalpur, Sirajganj, Bogra, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Brahmanbaria, Madaripur, Mymensingh, Netrokana, Pabna, Shariatpur, Habiganj and Sunamganj will get Taka two lakh each. While the districts of Comilla, Maulvibazar, Chandpur, Chittagong Cox's Bazar, Bandarban, Rangamati, Feni, Rangpur, Lalmonirhat, Joypurhat, Chapainawabganj, Nilphamari, Tangail, Sherpur, Naogaon and Magura will get Taka one lakh each.

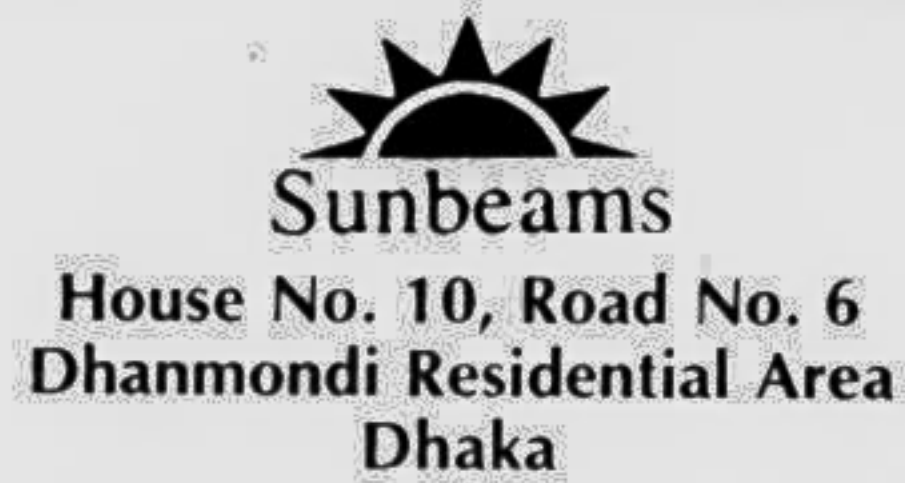
During the meeting, the ambassador conveyed greetings of the Vietnamese Prime Minister to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.
