64.88 pc pass Dakhil exam

Bangladesh Madrasa Education Board on Thursday announced the results of Dakhil examinations of 1998 in which 1,34,856 examinees appeared and 87,499 came out successful registering a 64.88 per cent rate of success, reports BSS.

The board sources said out of the total, 21,358 passed in first division, 60,057 in second division and 6,084 in third division.

A total of 39,054 female students appeared in this year's examinations.

This year under the general group, 1,22,014 examinees of which 37,247 female students appeared in the examination. A total 16,671 got first division, 55,598 second division and 5,955 third division.

The board sources said in Science group out of the total 11,902 passed in first division, 4051 in second division and 114 in third division. A total of 1,640 female examinees appeared in the examinations.

Under the Muzabbid Group, 926 examinees, of which 167 female students, appeared in the examination. A total 117 got first division, 402 got second division and 15 got third division.

In Hifzul Quran group 14 students sat for the examination of them four got first division and six got second division.

In the combined merit list results of the Dakhil examinations Mohammad Anisur Rahman stood first from Faridganj Majidia Alia Madrasa, Chandpur securing 891 marks while Mohammad Shafiqul Islam of Dhamati Islamia Alia Madrasa, Comilla and Saiful Islam Khondoker of Chhagalnaya Islamia Fazel Madrasa respectively became jointly second securing 879 marks.

Mohammad Delwar Hossain of Dhamati Islamia Alia Madrasa of Comilla stood third securing 864 marks in the merit list.

Film institute, media complex to be set up in city: Sayeed

State Minister for Information Prof Abu Sayeed yesterday said the present government is relentlessly working to revive country's film industry and flourish it properly through technology development and bring back discipline in the sector, reports BSS.

Inaugurating a three-month long film-making course in the Indian High Commission auditorium Prof Sayeed said steps have been taken to establish a 'Film Village' at Kabirpur to facilitate sound atmosphere for movie-making. "Besides, a film institute and a media complex at Agargaon will be set up in this regard," he said adding that the equipment of the industry would also be modernised.

Bangladesh Film Culture (BFC) organised the course titled 'Certificate Course in Film Making' in which 33 persons, mostly young and highly educated, are taking part.

Bangla Academy Director General Dr Syed Anwar Hossain presided over the inaugural function. Course Secretary M A Galur, President and General Secretary of BFC Zakul Huq and Sarkar Mahbubul Alam spoke on the occasion.

Prof Sayeed said Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman established Bangladesh Film Development Corporation (BFDC) in fifties with a view to producing qualitative films imbued with country's heritage and culture.

Prof Sayeed said the middle class people, the main cinema-goers and contributors to the film industry of the country, are losing their interest due to low quality of films in which elements of sound recreation and positive messages are absent. "Youths have come forward to make good films and instill patriotism in the minds of children and juvenile through their works," he said.

Dr Syed Anwar Hossain said excluding the exceptions there will hardly be found a good film made in the country for a long time.

He emphasised the need for a committed section of youths.

DRU Computer Club formed

Dhaka Reporters Unity (DRU) has formed a Computer Club with an aim to introduce all its members with modern information technology, says a press release.

Car-truck collision in city: Two killed

Two young men were killed and two others injured critically in a road accident at Ashulia under Uttara Thana in the city early yesterday, reports BSS.

Police said the accident occurred at about 4:30 am when a private car carrying four youths collided head-on with a truck.

All passengers of the car sustained critical injuries and two of them died.

The critically injured - Habib Noor Salm alias Bappa, 25, and Enamul Huq Chowdhury alias Jubaraj, 27, - were taken to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where the attending doctor declared them dead.

The other injured - Rassel, 28, and Mahub Ahmed Sonet, 26, - were taken to a private hospital.

Police said the youths went to Ashulia Bheribandh area after attending a marriage ceremony at Dhanmondi. The accident occurred when they were returning from there.

Bappa was the son of late A B M Firoz Ahmed of Khilgaon Tilapara area and Jubaraj was the son of Aminul Islam Chowdhury of Green Road Staff Quarters.

The condition of the injured youths is still critical, according to hospital sources.

The bodies of the youths were handed over to their relatives after autopsy at DMCH yesterday afternoon.

A case was registered with Uttara thana in this connection.
