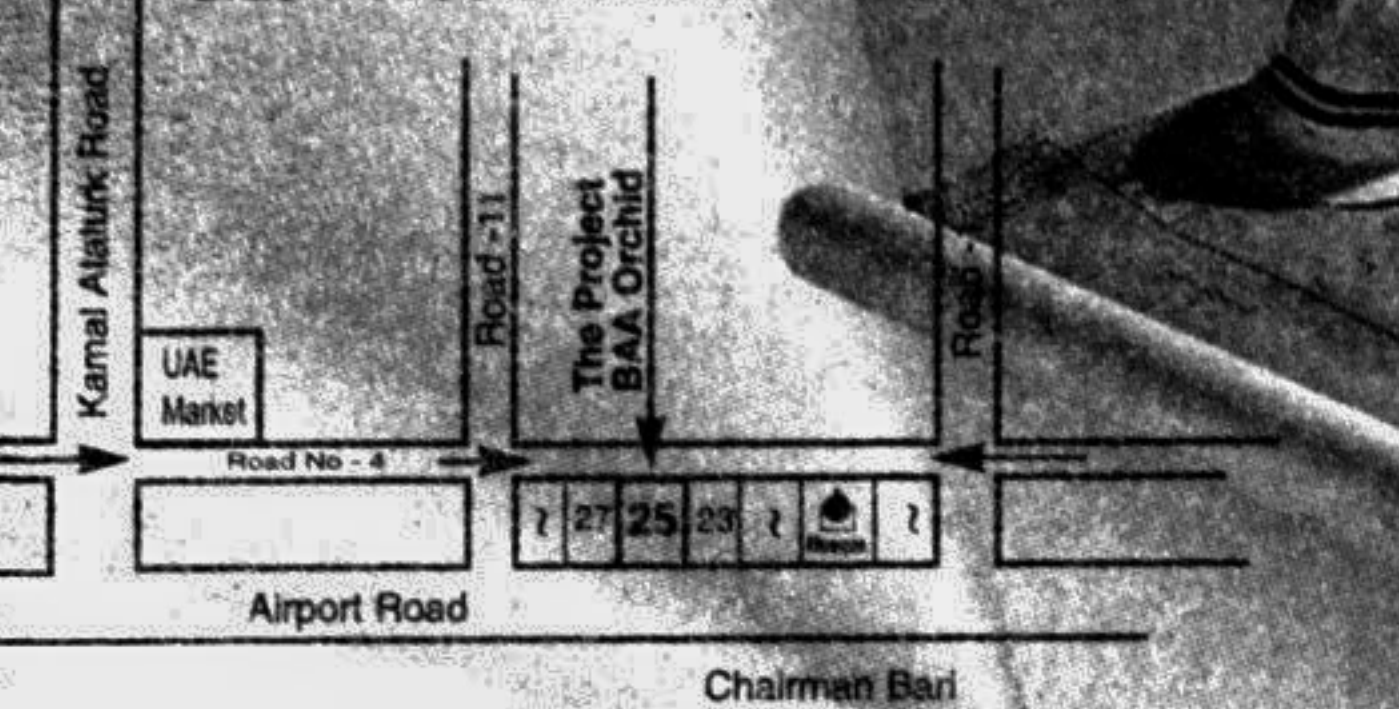

Three injured in clash over possession of land

Three persons sustained bullet injuries after two groups of locals, reportedly two factions of the ruling party, clashed following possession of a piece of land at city's Pallabi thana area in the morning yesterday.

Hospital sources identified the wounded as Hasan, 22, Rezaul, 40, Harun, 30.

They were admitted at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital soon after the incident.

Two groups of local Awami League activists exchanged bullets during the about fifteen minute long clash following long-drawn dispute over the piece of land on Avenue 2 in Mirpur section No. 12 at about 9 am, it is learnt.

A case was filed with Pallabi thana in this regard yesterday. None has been arrested yet.

Govt allocates more relief materials for flood-hit people

The government yesterday allocated more relief materials for the flood affected people of six districts, reports UNB.

Disaster Management and Relief Ministry sanctioned Tk three lakh for Sirajganj district. Tk two lakh each for Narayananganj, Chapainawabganj and Shariatpur and Tk one lakh for Bhola.

Besides, 200 mt rice were allotted for Narayananganj, Chapainawabganj and Shariatpur districts each, 100 mt for Sunamganj and Bhola districts, said an official handout.

The ministry has so far sanctioned Tk 3.14 crore, 67,562 mt rice, 1,50,194 pieces of sari, 49,150 pieces of lungi, 34,500 pieces of second-hand clothes, 14,200 meters of cloth, 7,000 pieces of scarf, 1000 pieces of dhuti, 8,330 tins of biscuit, 500 roles of polythene and dry-food.

DU to host Asia-Pacific Edn Confce in Sept

The first ever Asia-Pacific Education Conference will be held at Dhaka University in September this year, reports UNB.

The four-day conference, to be organised by Asian Student Association (ASA) in collaboration with all active student organisations of the country, will begin on September 5.

Education and Globalisation Amidst the Asian Financial Crisis, "Education and Employment," "Education and Women Rights," "Education and Democracy" and "Education and Human Rights" will be the main slogans of the conference.

Coordinator of the National Preparatory Committee and President of Chhatra Maitree Ziaul Huq Zia, made the disclosure at a press conference at DUCSU Bhaban yesterday.

Sixty-two student organisations of 30 countries of the Asia-Pacific region are the members of ASA.

BCL President Enamul Haq Shameem, General Secretary Ishak Ali Khan Panna, Hasan Hafizur Rahman Sohail, Karim Sikder, Dipanker Saha Dipu and Ashraf Shahu were present at the press conference.

Help build better Bangladesh, urges Health Minister

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf yesterday urged all to help build a better Bangladesh for the future generation, reports BSS.

He was addressing a meeting to mark the 23rd anniversary of martyrdom of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, organised by the National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases and Hospital in its auditorium, a PID handout said.

He said Bangabandhu had sacrificed his life for bringing smile on the faces of the wretched people. "We have to play our due role for materialising the ideals of Bangabandhu and achieve better life."

Zillur visits residence of missing LGED project director

Minister for LGED and Cooperatives Zillur Rahman yesterday visited the residence of Project Director of the Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) Md. Kamruzzaman Bhuiyan who was missing in a boat capsized during distribution of relief goods among the flood victims, reports BSS.

The LGED and Cooperative Minister along with senior engineers of the LGED department talked to the family members of Md Kamruzzaman Bhuiyan at his residence at Agamasih lane here and expressed deep sympathy for them.

His wife Jahanara Bhuiyan, mother Nataka Begum, daughter Asifa Zaman and four years old son Naved Bhuiyan were present while the minister was expressing his sympathy and concern, an official press release said.

Md Kamruzzaman Bhuiyan, drowned in a boat capsized after distributing relief goods in Srinagar thana of Munshiganj district last Friday, was still untraced, the press release said.

Vice-President of the Institution of Engineers of Bangladesh (IEB) Bhuiyan was leading a 20-member IEB relief team, the press release also said.

The rescue team of Bangladesh Navy and others out government and non-government levels under the direction of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina were pursuing their all-out efforts to rescue Md Kamruzzaman Bhuiyan.

The chief engineer of LGED Kamrul Islam Siddique is conducting the rescue operation in Srinagar of Munshiganj, the press release said.
