ADAB to continue relief operation

The Association of Development Agencies in Bangladesh (ADAB) has decided to continue and strengthen the relief operation in the flood affected areas of the country, reports UNB.

The association at an emergency meeting yesterday also urged the NGOs working at field-level to undertake post-flood emergency agriculture rehabilitation programme.

It stressed the need for a co-ordinated post-flood rehabilitation effort by both the government and the Non-Government Organisations.

The meeting observed that the relief operation in the flood affected areas should continue for another month.

Presided over by ADAB Chairperson Dr Kazi Farooq Ahmed, the meeting was attended, among others, by the ADAB director and 52 representatives from 45 NGOs.

Bangladesh Scouts open relief cell

Bangladesh Scout has opened a relief cell at its National Headquarters to carry out relief work for the flood affected people of the country, reports UNB.

The NHQ relief cell will remain open from 6 am to 10 pm everyday, and all concerned are requested to send their reports of the relief work in the relief cell, said a press release yesterday.
