Road accident in city: Four killed

Four persons, including a woman, were killed while at least twenty others were injured after a passenger bus hit a road side tree and fell into a ditch near Joar Sahara on New Airport Road under Cantonment thana in the city yesterday.

Police were yet to reveal the identity of the four till filing of this report last night. Hospital sources said of the dead there was an 25-year-old woman and three men aged around thirty.

The injured two, identified as Haider Ali, 70, and Nazrul Islam, 25, were admitted at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH). Hospital sources said, adding others were taken to Dhaka CMH and different hospitals and clinics in the city.

Police suspects that reckless driving resulted in the incident. The driver and other staff of the vehicle have been absconding since the incident, police said.

According to police, the mini bus left Sayedabad bus terminal for the Tongi at about 6:30 am. When the passenger-packed speeding bus neared the Joar Sahara police box at about 7 am, the driver suddenly lost control and hit a road side tree. The vehicle then fell into the road side ditch and overturned. Locals rushed to the spot and started the rescue operation. Later, police joined the effort.

The body of the four were recovered inside the over turned bus. Police sent those to DMCH morgue for autopsy and seized the bus.

A case was filed with the Cantonment thana in connection with the accident yesterday.

Garment workers raise 4-point demand

The garment workers have raised a four-point demand to save them from sufferings due to the flood that inundated most of their houses in low lying areas, reports UNB.

The demands were made from a rally of National Garment Workers Federation at Mukhtang in the city yesterday. Later, the garment workers brought out a procession that paraded city thoroughfares.

The rally was addressed, among others, by Federation leaders Amirul Haq Amin, Shabana Rahman, Shahida Sarker, Wahiduzzaman and Nahar, said a press release.

The demands are: aid allowance equivalent to one month's salary, Tk 30 daily as conveyance, rescheduling work hours from 9 am to 6 pm with a one-hour lunch break, and suspending overtime and night shift.
