WB approves \$32.4m credit for What's on today.... arsenic mitigation project

The World Bank on Thursday announced the approval of a 32.4 million US dollars credit for arsenic mitigation project to help Bangladesh alleviate arsenic contamination, said a Bank press release yesterday. reports BSS.

The World Bank (WB) said the project will provide alternative water supplies and emergency relief to people living in areas where arsenic-contaminated ground water is causing a major public health crisis with devastating effect on the lives of millions.

The total cost of the project has been estimated at 44.4 million US dollars with 32.4 million US dollars coming from the International Development Association (IDA), the Bank's concessionary lending affiliate. and 3 million US dollars from Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation.

The WB said the government of Bangladesh and the local communities are also contributing to the project while additional sources of funding

Bangabandhu Jubo Parishad organised the discussion in observance of the 23rd death an-






