
"I'm glad to come back to English football because the game

Laver leaves hospital

LOS ANGELES, Aug 28: Tennis great Rod Laver, who suffered a stroke while taping a television interview one month ago, was released from hospital on Thursday, reports Reuters.


The Australian left-hander. who lives in southern California, said he was making a good recovery after treatment and therapy in the University of California Los Angeles (UCLA) medical centre.

"I was very fortunate I was just across the road from this hospital that allowed me to, I guess, get here and go into the right sort of operation," he told a news conference following his release.

Laver, 60, also demonstrated for reporters that he had regained the ability to throw a tennis ball and swing a racket.

The red-headed Laver, whose powerful serve earned him the nickname "the rocket." is the only player ever to win two Grand Slams by sweeping all four major tennis championships in a calendar year — Wimbledon, the French, US and Australian Opens - in both 1962 an 1969.

With a total of 11 Grand Slam singles titles, Laver is tied for second all-time with Bjorn Bog behind Roy Emerson, who had 12 singles wins.



In the proposed system, the Super League would be the equivalent of the Champions League while the Pro-Cup would replace the current UEFA Cup

and Cup Winners' Cup. Hecht, who will hold talks with both the European Commission and UEFA next month, said Media Partners planned to launch their own television channel showing EFL games 24 hours a day.

Asked how many German clubs would play in the EFL, he said: "A minimum four in the Super League and six more in the Pro-Cup. The Bundesliga is certain to have 10 starters in the EFL.


