Relief operation BRAC employees donate one day's salary

The employees of BRAC have decided to donate their one day's salary to the relief operations undertaken by the organization in the flood affected areas of the country including Dhaka City, says a press release.

BRAC, which has over 20 thousand regular employees, is engaged in relief activities under its 221 Area Offices in 180 thanas of Bangladesh.

Early this month, Tk 2 crore was allocated by BRAC initially to launch relief operations in its programme areas. In Dhaka City, in addition to installation of tubewells wherever possible, bread, dry food, drinking water, ORS are being distributed and ten medical teams have also been deployed in flood affected areas.

Construction of new secretariat bldg discussed

The Parliamentary Standing Committee meeting on Housing and Public Works yesterday discussed the construction of new National Secretariat building at Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, reports UNB.

Presided over by committee chairman Akhtaruzzaman, the meeting also discussed the construction of new residential flats for the government officials and employees in the capital and Shahid Buddhijibi Memorial at Rayer Bazar and the Independent Monument in Suhrawardy Uddayan.

The meeting emphasised the need for quality control of the government construction work, said a press release.

Besides, overall activities of the Public Works Directorate and its organisational structure, manpower, budget allocation, progress of development projects and future development planning came up for discussion.

Committee members Nur-e-Alam Chowdhury, Haji Mohammad Selim, Mustafizur Rahman, Ms Rehana Akhter (Hira), Shamsuzzaman Duda, Muhammad Ahsanul Huq Molla, Abdul Mannan Talukder were present in the meeting.

Training course on NDT concludes

A two-day training course on 'Quality assurance and quality control' through non-destructive testing (NDT) for top level executives concluded at the Atomic Energy Centre on Sunday, reports BSS.

Organised by the Bangladesh Society for Non-Destructive Testing (BSNDT), the course was participated by 20 top level executives, scientists, engineers, industrialists and consultants of 13 organisations of oil, gas, fertilizer, refinery and other industrial and inspection and consulting establishments.

The course included lectures, demonstration and group discussions on different aspects of NDT technology for its wider application and attaining self-reliance in the country.

Dr M A Wazed Miah, chairman, Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission, was present as the chief guest and awarded certificates to the participants at a hotel the same day. Delwar Bakht, president of BSNDT presided.

Dr M A Wazed Miah, in his speech, stressed the importance of holding such training course for efficient, economic and safe application of NDT technology in Bangladesh.

3 killed in road accidents

Three persons were killed and 21 others injured in separate road accidents in Narayanganj and Mymensingh districts yesterday, report agencies.

The road accident on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway in Trisal thana left a man dead and 20 others injured.

Police said the accident occurred at about 4 pm when a Sherpur-bound bus from Dhaka skidded off the road and fell into a roadside ditch at Roy-mont. The man who died on the spot could not be identified.

In Narayanganj, two persons were killed and another injured in separate road accidents.

According to police sources, Nur Mohammad, 14, a worker of Kutuball Jewel Steel Mills, was killed on the spot when he was run over by a speeding truck.

In another incident, Abdus Samad, 40, was killed and a rickshawpuller was injured when a truck hit a rickshaw in which he was travelling at Sonarpur under Shiddhirganj thana.

- The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has approved the implementation of a Site Preparation Contract for a Power Project at a new site at Meghnaghat 22-km south-east of Dhaka city and has agreed to allocate the necessary funds for implementation of this part of the project. It is intended that the proceeds of this fund will be applied to eligible payments under the design and build (turnkey) contract for the implementation of this part of the project. The proposed conditions of contract is the FIDIC Conditions of Contract for Design-Build and Turnkey First Edition 1995.
- The Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) now invites international tenders for the design and implementation of a Site Preparation Contract for the Meghnaghat Power Project. The Site Preparation Contract will entail substantial raising of the formation level of a site on the north bank of the river Meghna just downstream of the Meghna Bridge.
- The site area to be filled is an area of approximately 100 hectares with an estimated volume of approx. 6.4 million cubic meters. The hydraulic fill is to be sourced from approved locations in and around the Meghna River to raise the site.
- River embankment protection to the filled site is required on three sides with a total length approaching 3.4-km and a protective embankment on land to the fourth side with a length of approximately 800 meters.
- All works under the design and build (turnkey) contract (Section 1, 2, 3) shall be completed within 300 days. However, all works under Section 1 & 2 shall have to be completed within 155 days from date of award of contract.
- The tenderers will be expected to be suitably qualified to undertake a work of this type and size.
