### SAPRI-BCI meet held

Dr Atiur Rahman. Matters pertaining to trade liberalisation, free market economy, privatisation, tariff barriers as well as various problems and prospects of the economic sector came up for discussion at the meeting.

Dr Wahiduddin Mahmud underscored the importance of reform programmes initiated by the present government. "We have to proceed to the right direction assessing the exact effect of the reforms," he said. BCI President Sharif M Afzal Hossain in his speech said domestic industries have to be made fit for competition through necessary protection by the year 2000 under the concept of WTO and necessary steps have to be taken in order to mordernise and standardise the industries.
