SAPRI-BCI meet held

The steering committee of Structural Adjustment Participatory Review Initiative (SAPRI) held a discussion with the directors and members of Bangladesh Chamber of Industries (BCI) to share experience regarding the effects of structural adjustment principles, reports BSS.
 The discussion was held on Thursday in the city. Chaired by BCI President Sharif M Afzal Hossain, it was attended by former Economic Adviser of the caretaker government Dr Wahiduddin Mahmud, Economists Dr Debapriya Bhattacharya, Zaidi Satter, Sayed Nizamuddin, Kapil Kapur and Dr Altair Rahman.
 Matters pertaining to trade liberalisation, free market economy, privatisation, tariff barriers as well as various problems and prospects of the economic sector came up for discussion at the meeting.
 Dr Wahiduddin Mahmud underscored the importance of reform programmes initiated by the present government. "We have to proceed to the right direction assessing the exact ef-

fect of the reforms," he said.
 BCI President Sharif M Afzal Hossain in his speech said domestic industries have to be made fit for competition through necessary protection by the year 2000 under the concept of WTO and necessary steps have to be taken in order to modernise and standardise the industries.

Army set up two more mobile water treatment plants

Bangladesh Army yesterday set up two more mobile water treatment plants at Vagalpur at Kamrangirchar and Sinnritek at Mirpur in the city for supplying pure drinking water to the flood victims, reports UNB.
 The plants, which can purify 500 gallons of water per hour each, will remain open from dawn to dusk everyday.
 Meanwhile, 20 army relief teams distributed 7,500 packets of prepared food, drinking water and water purifying tablets among the flood-hit people in the city yesterday.

3 children killed in road accidents

SIRAJGANJ, Sept 4: Three children were killed and six people injured in two separate accidents on the Bogra-Nagarbari highway today, police said, reports UNB.
 Two children, travelling in a micro-bus, died on the spot and six other passengers were injured when the vehicle slipped into a roadside ditch this noon at Shola Mile in Raiganj thana of the district.
 The Ullapara-bound micro bus was coming from Bogra.
 The two dead children were identified as Sumon, 7, and Babu, 5.
 The critically injured passengers were admitted to Bogra Mohammad Ali Hospital.
 In another accident, Nasir, 9, was run over by a speeding truck at Sharishakole in Shahjadpur thana.
 The truck fled the scene immediately after the accident.
