In commemoration of the day, winners from five different countries of the world including Bangladesh will receive UNESCO's 1998 International Literacy Prizes. The five prizes reward particularly effective contributions to the fight against illiteracy, one of UNESCO's major concerns. The accent this year was placed on actions benefiting women and girls.

A Silver Medal and the \$15,000 Malcolm Adiseshiah Literacy Prize, awarded for the first time this year, will be received by the Primary and Mass Education Division of Bangladesh for establishing a country-wide structure to implement literacy and establish special centres for women and girls in rural areas.

**Govt to offer facilities to expatriate Bangladeshis**

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday said the government will take necessary steps to offer all possible facilities to expatriate Bangladeshis who have a great role in earning foreign exchange for the country, reports UNB.

Talking to the newly-elected office bearers of Bangladesh Association of International Recruiting Agencies (BAIRA), she said the government has already taken steps to ensure that wage earners can send money to the country quickly and smoothly.

The Prime Minister told the recruiting agencies to motivate overseas wage earners to send money through banks. This will be beneficial both for them and the government, she said.

Hasina emphasised on proper training for workers to develop their skill to survive the competition in the international labour market.

She also stressed the need for setting up institutes to impart training to the workers. A block allocation has been kept in the annual budget for the training of workers, she said.

The government, she assured, will take adequate steps so as not to lose the international labour market.

The BAIRA leaders informed the Prime Minister that on their own initiative they will set up a training institute for the workers.

The BAIRA team placed various demands to the Prime Minister who assured that she will look into those.

BAAS science confee rescheduled for Oct 25-28

The three-day 20th science conference of Bangladesh Association for the Advancement of Science (BAAS) will now be held on October 25-28 instead of September 11-14 at the BUET campus, reports UNB.

The date of the conference has been changed due to the prevailing severe flood situation all over the country.

All intending participants are requested to register themselves at their own or nearby organisation as given in third announcement, says a press release yesterday.

The registration outside Dhaka closes on 15th October and at Dhaka on 23rd October. Other information regarding the conference will remain unchanged.

**NGOs concerned at repatriation of workers**

Non-government organisations (NGOs) working for the cause of migrants at a discussion meeting in the city yesterday expressed deep concern at the repatriation of Bangladesh workers from abroad and the government's indifference to them.

Held at Mirpur office of the Christian Commission for Development in Bangladesh (CCDB), the meeting particularly discussed the condition of those who have been sent back from Malaysia due to slump in economy in recent weeks.

Representatives from different NGOs also expressed concern over ill-treatment of repatriated workers at Zia International Airport upon their arrival at home. They urged the government to take immediate measures in mitigating suffering of Bangladeshis working abroad.

Hameeda Hossain of Ain O Salish Kendro (ASK), Joachim Victor Gomes of CCDB, Syed Saiful Haque Asif of Welfare Association of Repatriated Bangladeshis Employees (WARBE) and Manirul Alam of Shishu O Shasthya Unnyan Karjyakram attended the meeting.

**4 hurt while making bombs**

Four youngmen sustained bomb injuries allegedly while preparing bombs inside a house at old city's Lalbagh area yesterday morning.

Police identified the wounded as Atik, 22, Alam, 25, Atik Hossain, 24, and Selim 25. Accomplices of the injured bomb-makers admitted the four at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) soon after the incident. Being informed about the arrival of police at the hospital, the four escaped from the ward no: 31 of DMCH, police and hospital sources said.

The incident took place when a gang of criminals including the injured four were preparing explosives inside the house on Lalbagh Road.
