The report ranks Bangladesh as 147 in the Human Development Index (HDI) measures, in terms of life expectancy, education attainment and adjusted real income, said a UNDP press release.

According to the report, the world will consume a record US dollar 24 trillion in goods and services in 1998.

The report takes an unflinching look at the global consumption boom.


