

Meeting of Planning Commission

A meeting of the Planning Commission was held in the city yesterday with State Minister for Planning, Science and Technology Mohiuddin Khan Alamgir in the chair, reports BSM.

The meeting also discussed the issues of taking effective measures for production of foodgrains after flood, extension of various irrigation projects and sinking of deep and shallow tubewells, diversification of crops and providing assistance to the farmers.

The meeting discussed the demand of foodgrains, fixation of production target, damage to crops in the severe flood and other issues.

Different proposals were accepted to formulate projects for the development of the Chittagong Hill Tracts.
