

One electrocuted, another drowns

NAOGAON, Sept 11: One man was electrocuted and another child drowned in Sapahar thana of the district in the last two days till Thursday, reports UNB.

Control room sources said Maziz, 28, of Sapahar thana met the tragic end after coming into contact with live wire while rescuing people by a boat at Jaboi beel on Thursday.

The unidentified boy, about five years old, drowned in the flood water at Kulumdanga village on Wednesday.

Plans to repair damaged school bldgs

The government has undertaken three-point plans to resume classes of the educational institutions immediately after recession of flood waters, reports UNB.

The decision was taken at joint policy making meeting of the Education Ministry and Primary and Mass Education department in the city on Thursday with Education Minister ASHK Sadique in the chair.

Under the plan, directives have been given to take immediate steps to repair small damages of the school buildings where flood waters receded.

Secondly, measures will be taken to repair the institutions so that classes could be started and thirdly, plans have been taken to launch massive repair work of the educational institutions after assessing the damages.

The Minister directed the authorities to form survey committees comprising TNO, Engineer, Sub-assistant Engineer of the LGRD and Facilities Department to assess the damages.

C'wealth Sectt to extend help for flood victims

Commonwealth Secretariat will extend all possible help and assistance to mitigate the sufferings of the flood-affected people of the country, reports UNB.

It will also extend help to post-flood reconstruction and rehabilitation programme, particularly the damaged rural infrastructures and rural water supply.

The assurance came at a meeting when the visiting Commonwealth delegation led by its Local Government Director Carl Wright called on LGRD and Co-operatives Minister Zillur Rahman at his secretariat office on Thursday.

Zillur Rahman apprised the delegation of the trail of devastation caused by the two-month long flood which badly damaged huge rural roads, bridges, culverts and other rural socio-economic infrastructures.

Carl Wright conveyed the Commonwealth Secretariat General's concern over the flood situation in Bangladesh and its devastation and expressed sympathy to the flood victims.

He said a Commonwealth fact finding mission will survey and assess the extent of damages of rural infrastructures, rural water supply network and sanitation infrastructures.

The central committee meeting of Bangladesh Sangbadik Samity, scheduled to be held on September 15, had been postponed due to the devastating floods across the country, a press release of the samity said here yesterday, reports BSS.

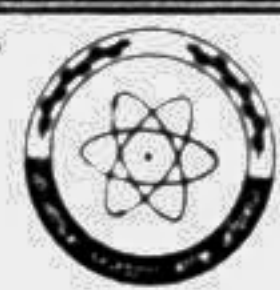
