Garments factory owners urged to pay workers' salary

Three lakh, out of some 15 lakh garments workers in the country, are not being able to carry on their duty due to the devastating flood while many others are yet to get their last month's salary and other benefits when living costs have increased substantially.

Srambikash Kendra, an organisation working for the causes of labourers, in a press release issued yesterday, described this situation, suggesting the garments owners to pay the workers' salaries and overtime benefits immediately.

The organisation noted that due to the flood situation, garment workers had to spend three times more comparing to their normal daily conveyance. It urged the factory owners to pay advance salary to the flood-affected workers, close day's work by six in the evening, not to keep women workers till late night, to provide assistance for rebuilding damaged houses of the workers and medical facilities for them.

USAID official due today

Thomas H Fox, Assistant Administrator for Policy and Programme Coordination for the US Agency for International Development (USAID) arrives in Dhaka today on a four-day visit, reports UNB. During his stay in Dhaka, Fox will meet with senior Bangladesh officials concerned with flood relief and economic development and will review USAID's range of activities in Bangladesh, said a USIS press release.

USAID to Bangladesh in the current fiscal stands at 95 million US dollars with an additional 71 million dollars provided as emergency flood relief.

Evacuees from UK embassy have been advised to return

Dependents of the British diplomatic staff and other employees who earlier left the capital due to deterioration of the flood situation, have been advised to return in view of the overall improvement, reports BSS.

A British High Commission press release said "most of those wives and children who were evacuated last week can now return."

The decision has been taken as most of their homes are now safe to return following significant fall in the flood water level. The high commission hoped that 45 out of 57 mothers and children who left the country on 9 and 10 September will be able to return by the middle of next week.

The remainder will return once their homes become fit for habitation, the press release said.

The British High Commission has passed similar advice to members of the British community in Bangladesh.

Mannan Bhuiyan condole death of ex-BNP MP

BNP secretary general Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan expressed deep shock at the death of former MP Rafiqul Islam Roni, reports UNB.

Roni suffered heart attack while distributing relief goods in his area, Chandpur, on Wednesday and died on way to hospital.

Bhuiyan prayed for peace of the departed soul and conveyed sympathy to the bereaved family.

Viral fever, foot sore break out in N'ganj

NARAYANGANJ, Sept 17: Viral fever and foot sore have broken out among the flood-affected people in different parts of the district particularly in the Pourasava area here in an alarming proportion, reports BSS.

Hospital sources said, about 60 per cent out-door patients at Narayanganj General Hospital and 200-bed Khanpur Hospital have been attacked with viral fever and foot sore.

The diseases are spreading fast causing concern among the people particularly the day labourers, rickshaw-pullers and push-cart drivers.

High temperature accompanied with spasmodic pain and headache are some of the symptoms of the viral fever while acute itching in the foot — are the symptoms of the foot sore, the source added.

The Civil Surgeon Office here when contacted told BSS that they were aware of the diseases and giving treatment to the patients through medical teams.

Relief committee formed

Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA) and Bangladesh Garments Sramik Oikya Parishad yesterday formed a 25-member joint relief committee with Lutfor Rahman (director and chairman, standing committee on labour, BGMEA) as its convener for helping the flood affected garments workers, a BGMEA press release said.
