India near another medal

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 18: India closed in more surprise badminton medals at the Commonwealth Games today when Pulella Gopichand reached the quarterfinals of the men's singles, reports AFP.

India have already won a team silver and bronze and Gopichand beat Pakistan's Mirza Ali 15-2, 15-1 in only 25 minutes in the most one-sided match of the fourth round.

Gopichand is now within one win of becoming the first Indian to win a singles medal since Syed Modi took the title in Brisbane in 1992.

The Indian number one played at too high a pace for Ali and has a good chance in his next match against unseeded Welshman John Leung.

A Gopichand success will be another feather in the cap of Prakash Padukone, the former all-England and Commonwealth champion who trains the national squad at his badminton academy in Bangalore.

With Aparna Popat also doing well in the women's singles, the ammunition with which Prakash can make his case to the Indian government for better funding is increasing all the time.

Leung, one of three Welshmen in the fourth round for the first time, beat Australian Stuart Brehaut 15-11, 15-10, his second successive victory over a seeded player.

It continued Leung's recovery from the knee injury sustained falling over in a tropical storm before the tournament, ruining hopes of doing well in the team event.

Bruce Flockhart of Scotland came through to play the favourite Yong Hyeok Kin, and another Mark Constable of England, progressed to a quarter-final with another Malaysian Wong Choon Han.

Constable's progress by 15-9, 15-11, against Geoff Bellingham only took place after the New Zealander had led 11-7 in the second game and then ripped his shoe apart thrusting for a smash at 11-10.

Bellingham had already torn two previously in the tournament and having no others with him at the arena he was left stranded. The rules prevent a player from leaving the court.

While coach Geoff Robson rushed out to grab a pair from a stall outside and was frantically trying to lace them up, Bellingham was top-sidedly trying to continue in one sock and one shoe, with the crowd cheering loudly.

Later Scotland gained their first medal for 12 years when Sandra Watt and Elinor Middlemiss, in her last tournament before retirement, reached the women's doubles semifinals with a win over Malaysians, Quay Yee Ling and Amin Norhashakin.

UEFA Cup Winners' Cup Champs sans sparkle

LONDON, Sept 18: Chelsea made heavy work of beating Swedes Helsingborg 1-0 on Thursday in their European Cup start to their European Cup defence.

The London club were not alone in struggling against lowly-ranked opponents.

Italian big-spenders Lazio, German representatives MSV Duisburg and Paris St Germain were all held 1-1 at home by teams who rarely feature in the later rounds.

Malorca of Spain bucked the trend with a well-earned 1-0 win in Scotland against Hearts while Heerenveen flew the Dutch flag with a 3-1 win over Amica Wronki of Poland.

No team has ever retained the Cup Winners' Cup but, in what could be its last year of existence, Chelsea would have fancied their chances looking at this season's threadbare field.

But they had only Franck Lebouef's 43rd minute free kick to show for their efforts against a team who knocked Aston Villa out of the UEFA Cup two years ago.

Italian international Pierluigi Casiraghi hit a post with his first touch after coming on as a second-half substitute but Chelsea deserved little more.

Lazio, Runners-up in last season's UEFA Cup, spent close on 100 million dollars in the

close season but made a disastrous start against Lausanne Sports when young midfielder Dejan Stankovic was sent off after just two minutes for handling a goal-bound shot.

Fabio Celestini's resultant penalty was saved by Luca Marchegiani and Lazio then went ahead when Pavel Nedved headed home a Marcelo Salas cross in the 37th minute.

But the Swiss grew in confidence after the break and in the 54th minute Philippe Douglas side-footed in a cross from Marc Hottiger for a deserved draw.

Duisburg, back in Europe after a 19-year absence, needed an 83rd minute goal by substitute Marcus Wedau to salvage a draw against 10-man Genk.

The Belgians had midfielder Marc Hendrik sent off in the 57th minute but went ahead four minutes later with a header by Finland midfielder Juha Reini from a corner.

PSG, winners in 1996, were lacklustre throughout as they were held by Israel's Maccabi Haifa.

The Parisians, who were also losing finalists in 1997, opened the scoring with a Marco Simone penalty in the 82nd minute but the Israelis hit back five minutes later thanks to gifted striker Ysoi Benayoun.

Malorca made a flying start to their first season in Europe, beating Hearts with a messy goal in the 17th minute when

home-keeper Gilles Rousset pounced a corner straight on to the chest of Elena Marcelino and saw the ball bounce into the net.

Heerenveen beat Amica Wronki 3-1 with goals from Jeffrey Talan, Dumitru Mituta and Boudewijn Pahlplatz, Grzegorz Kotla's reply kept the Poles in the tie.

Newcastle, like Chelsea, face an awkward second leg after scraping a 2-1 home win over Partizan Belgrade.

Alan Shearer put Ruud Gullit's side ahead after 12 minutes but a Vuk Rasovic penalty levelled in the 68th. Greek defender Nikolaos Dabizas headed the winner three minutes later.

Australian side Ried marked their European debut with a 2-0 home victory over MTK Budapest, Gerald Strafer and Ronald Brunmayr stunned the 20 times Hungarian champions.

Goals by Yevgeny Kharlachev and Zaza Dezhnashvili gave Lokomotiv Moscow a comfortable 2-0 win at Ukrainian side CSKA Kiev.

Lokomotiv, semifinalists last season, controlled the match and had too much experience and pace up front.

Besiktas of Turkey beat Spartak Trnava of Slovakia 3-0. FC Copenhagen collected a useful 2-0 away win against Levski Sofia and Panionios Athens beat Finnish side Haka Valkeakoski 2-0.

Gunners, MU meet in match of the week

LONDON, Sept 18: Arsenal and Manchester United will cast disappointing European results aside Sunday as English soccer focus returns to a battle of the Premier league giants, reports AP.

Arsene Wenger's FA Cup and League-double titlists had a 1-1 tie with Lens, while Manchester United surrendered a 2-0 advantage to slump to a 3-3 draw at home with Barcelona in Champions' League opener Wednesday.

But Arsenal and Manchester United, who finished No 1 and No 2 in the league last season, will put all their resources into the clash at Highbury.

The teams have played once already this season, the Gunners winning the annual Charity Shield match 3-0 in August.

The Gunners, minus former captain Ian Wright — who transferred to West Ham in the off-season — have only one win and four ties in five league games.

The major concern for Wenger in has been the indifferent form of Dutch striker Dennis Bergkamp, who has not scored a goal in the domestic competition since returning from the World Cup.

Bergkamp, a key player in Arsenal's campaign last season with 16 league goals and three cup goals, has admitted to suffering from post-World Cup burnout.

Manchester United are in fifth place in the standings with two wins and two ties from four games and has started to fire since star striker Dwight Yorke arrived from Aston Villa.

Yorke, a 12.6-million-pound (20 million dollars) signing, has scored three goals in United's last two league games.

The sixth round kicks off with eight matches Saturday, with league-leading Aston Villa at third-place play Leeds United.

Villa, undefeated at the top of the Premier League standings with four wins and tie, fought back from two goals down to es-

cape with a 3-2 win at home over Norway's Stromgset in a UEFA Cup match Tuesday.

Villa trailed 2-1 after a goal in the 83rd minute and then got two goals in injury time from 18-year-old Darius Vassell to clinch the victory.

Despite his winning double, Vassell is almost certain to remain on the reserves bench against Leeds at Elland Road.

Leeds were forced to fight for a 1-0 win over Portugal's Maritimo in the UEFA Cup Tuesday but secured the first-leg result when Jimmy Floyd Hasselbaink scored in the 84th minute.

Former England international Robbie Fowler and 18-year-old sensation Michael Owen should be reunited as Liverpool's striker pairing against Charlton at Anfield.

Liverpool scored a 3-0 win over Kosice in the UEFA Cup Tuesday after an unexpected 2-1 loss to West Ham last weekend cost the Merseysiders the No. 1 spot in the standings.

COMMONWEALTH AT A GLANCE

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 18: Malaysia picked up its fifth gold medal Friday when Nurul Huda Baharin won the women's individual air rifle event at Langkawi Island. She scored 494.8 points to win from Sharon Boves of Canada (493.3) and Louise Minnett of England (491.7), reports AP.

Canada's James Paton won the men's individual full-bore rifle gold medal with 402 points. Malaysia's Zainal Abidin Md Zain took the silver with 400 and Andrew Luckman of England collected the bronze, also with 400.

Canadian Metod Igrorov added a gold in the men's rapid fire pistol competition while New Zealand's Stephen Peterson, who won two golds in small-bore rifle shooting in the 1994 games, won another in the men's free rifle prone event.

New Zealand also won the first medal on offer in cricket at the Commonwealth Games when it beat Sri Lanka by 51 runs in the bronze medal playoff.

Allrounder Chris Harris was the star with an unbeaten 55 in the Kiwis-212-7 off 50 overs and took two wickets as Sri Lanka was all out for 161 in the 45th. Australia will play South Africa for the gold Saturday.

England claimed three gold and three silver medals in the 85-kilogram weightlifting division. Lenn Griffin won two golds for the overall and clean and jerk sections and silver in the snatch. Steve Ward had the snatch gold and silver in two sections.

England's three weightlifting golds and Canada's two in shooting move them to 19 and 16 respectively behind runaway leader Australia at 50.

Welsh pair Iwan Thomas and Jamie Baugh were to tussle for the 400-meter title, and were expected to take the final more seriously than they did the semi, when the pair held a conversation down the stretch.

Chinese upbeat

BEIJING, Sept 18: China can achieve its goal of winning 20 gold medals from track and field in the upcoming 13th Bangkok Asian Games without coach Ma Junren's runners, a top official said here on Friday, reports Xinhua.

Shang Xiutang, secretary general of the Chinese Athletics Association (CAA), said that the absence of 'Ma's family army' will not affect China's status as Asia's leader in track and field.

'We're confident to win 20 gold medals at the Asian Games in December,' Shang said.

Chinese athletes, who usually bury their heads in training and adjustment after a while year's competition in December, are working hard to adapt themselves to Bangkok's hot conditions.

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 18 (AP): Malaysia is going to make a profit from the 1998 Commonwealth Games, the chief organizer said Friday.

Sukom '98, the organizing committee, expects a surplus of 5 million ringgit (1.5 million dollars), said executive chairman Hashim Mohd Ali.

The profit would be a pleasant surprise because Sukom has struggled to balance its books since Malaysia sank into an economic crisis over the last year and funds for the games were slashed by 10 per cent.

The surplus we forecast is after we settle all our dues, including the teams' rights with the Olympic Council of Malaysia, Hashim said.

Hashim said the company's two major shareholders — the government and the OCM — would decide where the surplus should go.

The committee had organized the 10-day event with 360 million ringgit (95 million dollars).

Malaysia has also spent millions of dollars on building and upgrading sports arenas, including the Bukit Jalil stadium, which cost 300 million dollars to build.

VILLAGE RATS

Officials under pressure to keep up hygiene and sanitation standards at the athletes' village have caught one dozen rats this month.

Health staff also have been spraying anti-mosquito chemicals every four days.

Concern about health was triggered by cases of suspected cases of dengue fever in the village.

So far, a New Zealand team doctor and a Malaysian athlete have been diagnosed with the potentially fatal disease carried by mosquitoes. An Australian team official and the wife of an official have been hospitalised with suspected dengue fever.

LUCY EXPELLED

Australian world individual pursuit champion Lucy Tyler Sharmann was expelled from the Commonwealth Games today.

The decision was taken by Australian team officials after the 33-year-old lashed out at her coach Charlie Walsh after failing on Thursday to qualify for the finals.

The American-born Sharmann claimed her equipment had been tampered with, sabotaging her gold medal challenge.

'It is my decision that Lucy should relinquish her place in the Australian Commonwealth Games team,' said Australian team boss Don Stockins on Friday after a hastily called meeting.

Lucy acknowledged my decision and we both agreed that she should leave the village as soon as possible.

Sharmann had been due to take part in the bronze medal race later on Friday but instead she was heading for the airport and home.

The decision to throw Sharmann off the team was fully backed by Ray Godkin, head of the Cycling Australia.
