**British Council lecture series on science**

The British Council in collaboration with the Ministry of Science and Technology is organising a series of public lectures on various aspects of science and technology, says a press release.

As a part of this series, a lecture on Flood 1998 will be delivered by Prof Amin Nishat, Country Representative, IUCN, at 4:00 pm Thursday at the British Council auditorium in the city.

Other lecture topics will include: The nature of floods in Bangladesh, factors relating to the duration of remaining flood water, experience of the Flood Action Plan '88 and its validity under present circumstances, preparations for the future to avoid another flood disaster. Each lecture will be followed by open discussion, and will be open for all.

**81 tons of Saudi relief goods arrive in city**

A cargo plane of Royal Saudi Airlines carrying 81 metric tons of relief goods reached Zia International Airport yesterday, reports UNB.

The relief goods include 1,426 cartons of rice, soyabean oil, date-palms, chips, milk powder, 370 cartons of medicines and 435 tents, said an official handout.

Joint Secretary of the Disaster and Relief Ministry M Shamsul Islam received the relief materials from the Saudi Ambassador to Bangladesh Abdullah Omar Bari.

The Saudi Ambassador lauded Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's prompt steps to mitigate the sufferings of the flood victims through proper distribution of relief materials and assured of further assistance from his government.

**Kuwait assistance for flood victims**

Kuwait Joint Relief Committee and Kuwait Zakat House are planning to provide healthcare and set up low cost houses in selected flood affected areas, reports UNB.

A two-member team comprising Bader Al-Shamroukh and Sateh Al-Khusrum are now in the capital to personally supervise the on-going relief activities of Dhaka-based Kuwaiti NGO and the Kuwait Embassy.

In the first phase, they distributed essential foodstuff and other goods among 5,000 families in Dhamrai and Narayanganj.

An official of the Kuwait Embassy here said the Joint Relief Committee and Zakat House are expected to begin the second and the third phase of their programmes from middle of next month.

Under the programme, flood victims in the worst affected areas would be given healthcare and low cost housing.

**WASA takes up measures to repair city's water, sewerage lines**

Dhaka WASA has taken up a number of short and long term measures to repair the damage caused to water and sewerage lines and drainage system in the city, reports UNB.

Forty-four deep tubewells out of 236 were affected by the flood while operation of 13 submerged pumps was suspended.

Seven pumps resumed operation and six others remained inoperative till yesterday, WASA officials said.

The inoperative pumps will be restored gradually with recession of flood water. Water supply will be ensured at pre-flood level through rapid rehabilitation work.

WASA officials said unhygienic condition is prevailing in some parts of the city because of mixing of flood water with sewerage. Most of the sewerage lifting stations in eastern part of the city were also rendered inoperative.

However, measures have been taken to keep the sewerage system functioning by repairing the sewerage pumps. Pagla sewerage treatment plant, operation of which was suspended on Sept 11, was reopened Sept 18.

Meanwhile permanent and temporary pumping machines are in operation round the clock in different city areas to pump out stagnant water.

Permanent pumps are located at Kallyanpur, Dholaikhal and Narinda while 79 temporary pumps are installed

at Rampura, Fakirapul, Lalbagh, Shahidnagar, Nababganj, Hazaribagh, Rayerbazar, Golarke, Diabara and Goran Chatbari.

The special drive of pumping out stagnant water will continue till the situation returns to normal, said WASA officials.

Meanwhile, WASA, CARE, BRAC, Muktiyoddha Sangsad and other social organisations have been organising around 4.5 lakh litres of fresh water everyday free of cost in flood shelter centres and affected areas. The arrangement will continue till the situation becomes normal.

The city dwellers have been urged to drink water after boiling it, as contaminated flood waters got into 600 km WASA water lines.

**Special art show at Shilpakala Gallery ends today**

The Special Art Exhibition of eminent artists, being held at the Shilpakala Academy Gallery in aid of flood victims, ends today, says a press release.

Some 111 art works by 96 artists on display are being sold at a relatively low price. In the meantime, 46 art works have been sold for Tk 2,65,000.

On behalf of the artists, the sale proceeds from the exhibition will go towards helping the flood affected people.

The exhibition will remain open from 2 pm to 8 pm today.
