## Import of 'tempo' BELA serves legal notice on secys

Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association (BELA) yesterday served a legal notice upon the Secretaries, Ministry of Environment and Forest, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Commerce, Ministry of Finance, chairman, National Board of Revenue, Chief Controller of Import and Export, Director General, Department of Environment, Chairman, Bangladesh Road Transport Authority & Rupali Bank Limited regarding importation of two-stroke engine vehicle popularly known as 'Tempo' despite legal prohibition and governmental decision against doing so, says a press release.

The notice mentioned in violation of the decision of the meeting of National Environment Committee under the chairmanship of Prime Minister, the Rupali Bank Limited has approved a loan of Taka 6 (six) crore for importation of two-stroke engine 'tempo' despite the fact that these two-stroke engine vehicle have been contributing largely in deterioration of the air quality of the city making vulnerable the city-dwellers to hazardous health effect.

It also argued that, such inconsiderate and irresponsible action by the Bank amounts to gross disregard to existing laws and regulations and would aggravate the present pollution status of the city environment.

The notice pointed out that, earlier another loan sanctioned by a consortium of four government owned bank for import of baby taxis has been stayed by the Bangladesh Bank after vehement protest from the members of the civil society.

Under the above circumstances, BELA has demanded to take immediate action for cancelling the sanction of loan for importation of tempo and requested to inform within 15 days of receiving the notice, failing which necessary legal action would be initiated.

## Dhaka elected vice president in IAEA confce

Bangladesh was unanimously elected Vice President of the 42nd session of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), says a press release.

The conference attended by the ministries and dignitaries representing 128 Member States is the most important annual event of this Specialised Agency of the UN system.

Some milestone decisions on various aspects of nuclear energy are likely to be addressed in this year's conference. Election of Bangladesh as a Vice-President is seen as a recognition of the country's impeccable credentials with regard to peaceful application of atomic energy as well as its deep commitment to non-proliferation of nuclear weapons.

The Bangladesh Delegation is led by the renowned nuclear scientist Dr M A Wazed Miah, the Chairman of the Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission. The delegation also includes Ambassador Dr Iftekhar Ahmed Choudhury, Permanent Representative of Bangladesh to the UN offices in Geneva and Vienna.

## Admission to DRU course begins

Admission to third batch of computer training course under the aegis of Dhaka Reporters Unity (DRU) has begun. Interested DRU members have been requested to get their names registered with a course fee of Taka 1,000 by October 6, says a press release.

Meanwhile, DRU Computer Club has launched a membership drive. Membership fee per annum is Taka 300 and application form Taka 20. Forms are now available at the club at DRU office at Segunbagicha.

The club would provide internet and e-mail facilities to its members. A data bank is also underway, the press release added.

## GCO demands publication of JU report on rape incidents

SAVAR, Sept 23: Gananatrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO) staged a demonstration of Jahangirnagar University campus today demanding publication of the full report of the Fact Finding Committee on rape incidents, reports UNB.

The committee, formed to probe three incidents of rape on the campus, submitted its report to the authorities on Monday.

A Syndicate meeting was held on Tuesday to discuss the report, but was adjourned till 11 am tomorrow (Thursday) without any decision regarding the disclosure of the names of culprits involved in the incidents.

Addressing a press conference today, GCO leaders threatened to go for an indefinite strike if the Syndicate fails to disclose the name mentioned in the report.

They also announced a gherao programme at the administrative building from 11 am tomorrow.

## More govt relief for flood victims

The government has allocated 525 metric tons of more rice and Tk one lakh for some flood affected districts of the country, reports UNB.

Disaster Management and Relief Ministry yesterday sanctioned 100 metric tons of rice for each of Madaripur and Kurigram districts, 75 metric tons of rice for Dhaka, and 50 metric

tons of rice for each of Shariatpur, Pabna, Rangpur, Barisal and Nilphamari districts.

Besides, Tk 50,000 has been allocated for each of Dhaka and Madaripur districts.

With this, the total allocation of the Ministry stands at 89,577 metric tons of rice, 750 metric tons of wheat and Tk 5.17 crore.
