BFUJ, DUJ ask members to rally round union to resist conspiracy
Leaders of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) yesterday expressed their deep concern at the attempt by a section of owners of newspapers and news agencies against the Fifth Wage Board Award and its implementation, reports BSS.
In a joint statement, BFUJ president Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury and secretary general Abul Kalam Azad and DUJ acting president Suhrah Rahman and general secretary Azizul Islam Bhuyian called upon the union members to rally round the union to unitedly resist the conspiracy against the Wage Board Award.
The journalist leaders pointed out that the Fifth Wage Board was formed as per Newspaper Employees (conditions of service) Act 1974 passed in the parliament and the government, through a gazette notification, announced the Wage Board Award on May 29, 1997. They said as per law of the land, the implementation of the award is mandatory for all newspaper owners and managements. They noted that the award had already been implemented by all leading newspapers and news agencies, including the Ittefaq, the Bangladesh Observer, Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS), UNB, the Sangbad, The Daily Star, and the Khabor.
The leaders said the union had submitted its demands to those managements who are yet to implement the award, and in some cases the journalists and employees have placed their demands before the courts.
They said besides depriving the journalists and other employees of their legitimate salaries and benefits, a section of newspaper owners indulged in violating the laws by not giving appointment letters, and regular salary.
Sounding a serious note of caution against such conspiracy to deprive the journalists of their legitimate and due salaries and benefits, the journalist leaders said that the conscious members of the profession would thwart all such conspiracies through united resistance.

'Save Dhaka, Clean Dhaka' programme begins today
Dhaka District Rover Scouts will start 'Save Dhaka-Clean Dhaka' activities from today. Around 500 Rovers and leaders will actively participate in the programme under the leadership of Deputy Commissioner, Dhaka, who is also the president of District Scouts and Rovers, says a press release.
Meanwhile, Bangladesh Scouts has produced 1,43,369 sachets of oral saline (ORS) and 23,800 sachets of water purifying Itikari (alum) for distribution among flood affected people all over the country. Rover Scouts (Boys and Girls) have been working on the two projects since September 2.
Bangladesh Scouts has also established another ORS project at Kishoreganj with the support of the local district administration, which is producing three to four thousand sachets each day since 18 September.
So far, 1,37,570 sachets of ORS has been distributed to 33 districts across the country.

Donors pledge Tk156 m for flood victims

Different donors have pledged more than five million Swiss francs equivalent to Taka 156 million, for the victims of worst ever flood in Bangladesh in response to the appeal of International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRCS), officials of the IFRCS in the city told BSS yesterday.
The IFRCS launched the first international appeal on July 30 seeking Taka 85 million for flood relief and medicare activities in the country. As the flood situation continued to worsen it launched a revised appeal on September 10 seeking Taka 312 million for providing emergency food, medicare, vegetable seeds, sarees and water containers. IFRCS delegate Torben Lindberg said.
"The response so far has been very positive," Torben said adding "the contributors till Thursday are Dutch Red Cross, Dutch government, Danish government, American Express, European Community Humanitarian office, German Red Cross, Swedish Red Cross, Japanese Red Cross, Iceland Red Cross, Danish Red Cross, Korean Red Cross, American Red Cross, Austrian Red Cross.
British Red Cross, Canadian Red Cross, Swiss Red Cross and Spanish Red Cross societies.
Referring to the huge damage in the agricultural sector, he said most of the seedbeds in the flood affected areas were destroyed which increased the need for crop and vegetable seeds.
"Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) will supply vegetable seeds to 500,000 flood affected people, belonging to the one lakh families, to supplement their diet and income in the coming winter," he said.
With IFRCS funding the BDRCS will procure spinach, radish, tomato and pumpkin seeds for the farmers while 50,000 plastic water containers and 100,000 sarees will be available for the worst hit people, the IFRCS officials said.
Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) officials said with IFRCS assistance more than 400 metric tonnes of flattened rice (chiral), 80 mt of molasses (gur), 804 mt of rice and 134 mt of lentils were distributed among the people by the BDRCS staffers and volunteers in different flood-hit districts.
