Around 1000 distressed people were given free treatment and medicines.



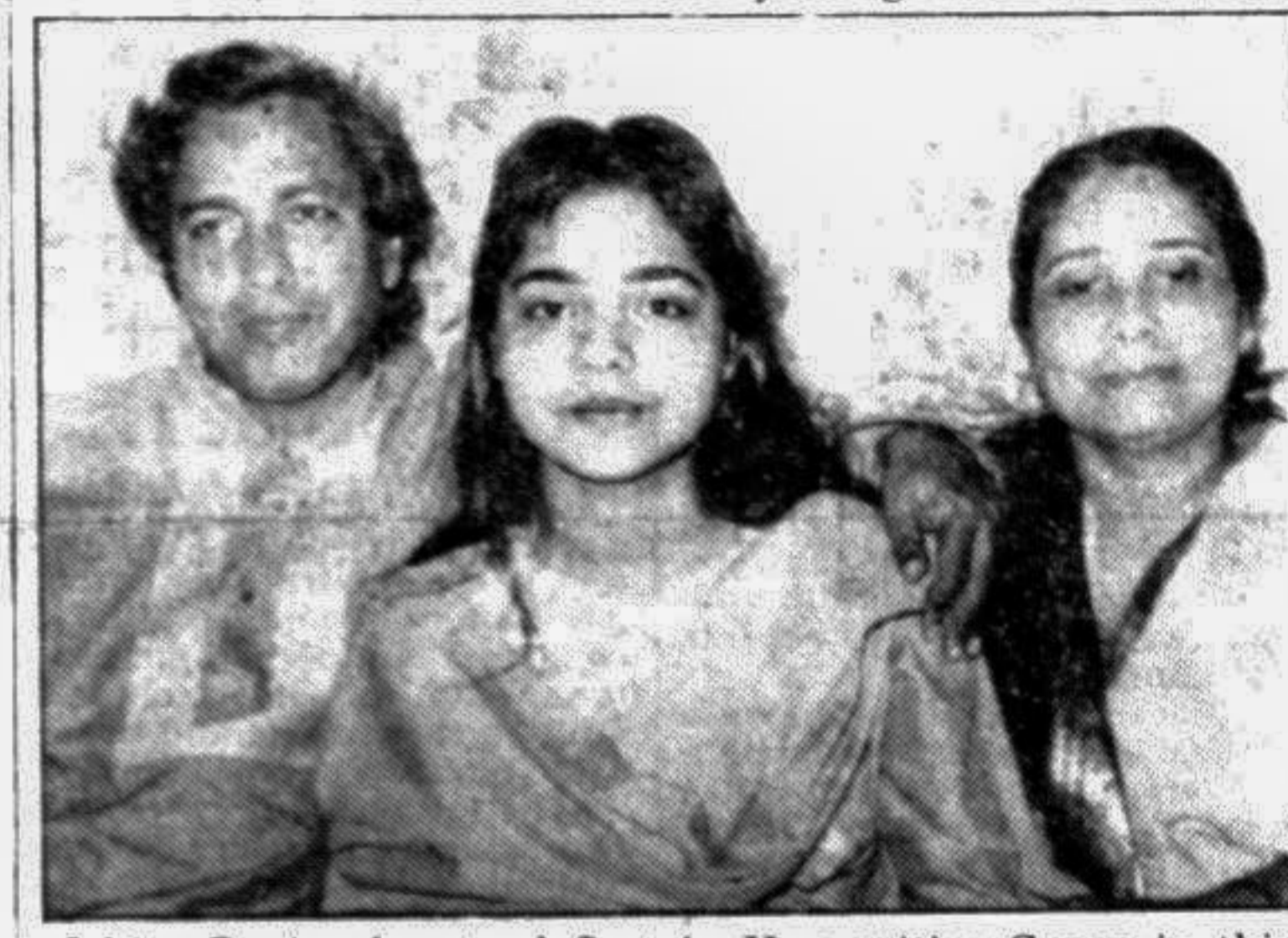

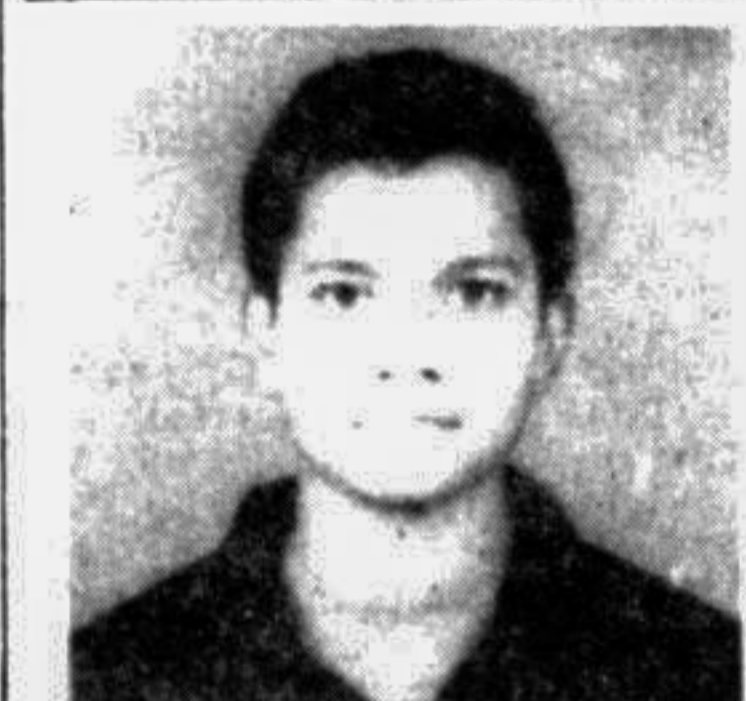

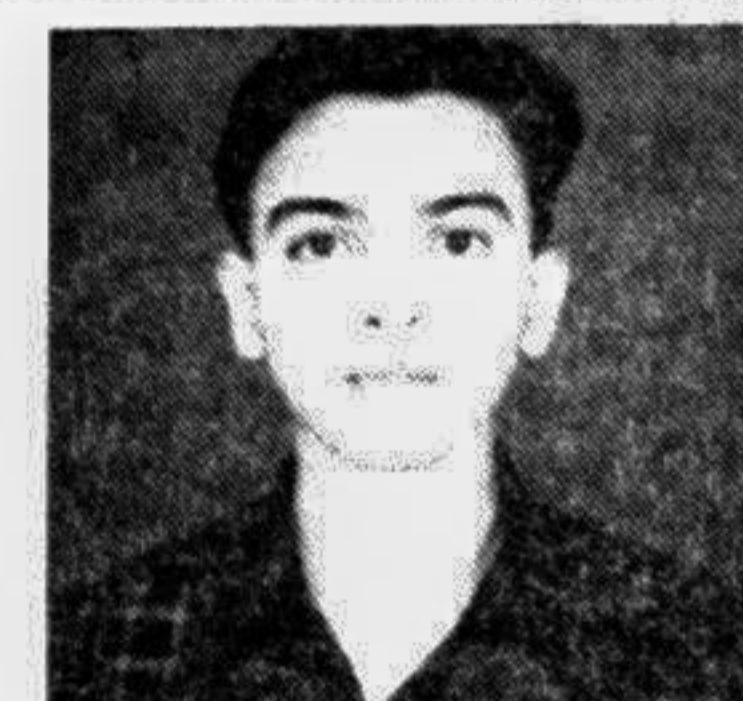


Tahmina Zaman, who topped the Humanities Group in the HSC examination from Dhaka Board, seen with her mother. — Star photo
