"I'm not yet in top form, but that's because of starting the pre-season preparations late. he said. Then I had a knee injury. It took a knock against Perugia and then another in the same place against Cagliari.

There's been some internal bleeding and it still hurts. It's annoying, but not enough to stop me from playing and I hope

it passes off soon. "But don't worry, the real Zidane is on his way and I want to

prove that as soon as possible starting on Saturday," he said. "So far, I've never been able to show what I can really do at Parma. But this time I hope I will. Alessandro Del Piero has said he just needs one goal to get

going again and I need one too. Perhaps even two goals." Parma, who will probably be fielding his World Cup team mates Lilian Thuram and Alain Boghossian, have so far only

garnered two points from two "I am surprised that Parma haven't been able to do better." Zidane admitted. "Two points

doesn't seem right. But the team has changed a lot and it's always difficult at the beginning. "Every team struggles at the start of the season, but the fact that we've taken all six points so far is important because

they'll be all the more precious

later in the season.

"In fact, this match comes just at the right time," he told the Gazzetta Dello Sport. "We can take three points off a direct rival in front of their own

# Weary Gazza fights for recall





eyes and in the way he plays. It is as though he knows that, whatever he does or says, he's going to provoke a firestorm of criticism. Tomorrow, he and his Middlesbrough team-mates travel to Chelsea.

One felt sorry for Gascoigne when his assumption that he would be going to the World Cup was derailed by headlines accusing him of spectacular socialising. All I had was a kebab and I've been slaughtered for it." he said.

That serene afternoon at Bisham Abbey was a mere appetiser for the feast of acrimony that was to follow Glenn Hoddle's squad selection announcement.

Doubts about the fitness of David Batty and the absence from the Bulgaria match of the suspended David Beckham and Paul Ince, who could also miss the Luxembourg game if UEFA so decree, might open the door once again for Gascoigne.

But before that can happen, both men must swallow some pride and with Hoddle's record in this department, thats unlikely tohappen.

If he's fit in mind and body and prepared to observe the Hoddle guidelines, Gascoigne will be considered a contender. Although he wasn't selected for the opening European tie in Sweden.

Having listened to Robson's advice and applied himself to the rigours of training.Gascoigne is now as close as he's going to get to peak condition. That, at least, is the view of those who play with him He's as good as anyone in the country, is the verdict of his team-mate Andy Townsend.

If he thinks it's worth the effort, Hoddle could check for Hoddle, who will be without himself tomorrow by paying a visit to his old club, Chelsea.


