ing (VGF) programme. Each of the families will get 8 kg of rice and 8 kg of wheat, free of cost, in the month of October and November, State Minister for Disaster Management and Relief Talukder Abdul Khaleq told UNB on Sunday.

The period may be further extended until the next harvest. he said adding that the government has enough stock of food to conduct the extended VGF

programme. The state minister said whenever a family is given a VGF card, it is ensured of 16 kg food-grains a month, the State Minister said.

The government started the VGF programme this year from August and since then some 1.3 million families were getting

their homes with new hopes.

months (October-November). With the recession of flood water, evacuees mostly returned home from flood shelters and are rebuilding their damaged houses — a major concern for

The Food-For-Work (FFW) programme will begin from the first week of October to provide job to those who lost their

livelihoods in flood. The government has a regular budget of 110,000 tons of food-grains for the FFW while the Relief Ministry sought additional allocation of 225,000

tons for the flood victims.

Some 50,000 tons of foodgrains have been earmarked for the current Test Relief (TR) programme while an extended TR programme will begin in mid-October, Khaleq said. "Jobs should not be a prob-

lem," he said adding that there are also works under many departments like LGED, Roads and Highways, Water Development Board, and Railway.
