Housing facilities for 30,000 landless families soon

The government has taken steps to provide housing facilities for 30,000 floating families in the first phase under a massive rehabilitation programme. reports UNB.

~ The LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman said people rendered homeless by the flood and river erosion will be rehabilitated through housing projects in different districts. The housing projects will help reduce the pressure of floating population on the

towns and cities.

Speaking at a meeting on the occasion of World Habitat Day as the chief guest at Shishu Park yesterday, the minister urged the non-government organisations to come forward in supplementing the efforts of the government.

Rehabilitation and Development Organisation for Landless (RADOL) organised the meeting in cooperation with LGRD and Cooperative Ministry and Ministry for Housing and Public Works. The main theme of the Day this year is 'safer

Director General of RADOL and member of National Habitat Committee Syed H Loton presided over the meeting.

Zillur said all thana headquarters of the country will be gradually upgraded as Municipality.

Construction of two satellite towns on the outskirts of the capital city is progressing. He said the satellite towns will help reduce the pressure of floating people and keep the capital safe. Lower-middle and middle class will get the housing facility in those areas.

Among others, Housing and Public Works Minister Mohammad Nasim and State Minister for Land Alhaj Rashed Mosharraf also spoke at the unction.

Later, different NGOs, government organisations and people from all walks of life participated in a procession that ended at Osmani Uddyan.

US grants \$ 1.3m to UNICEF for providing aid in flood-hit areas

The United States has granted 1.3 million US dollars to UNICEF to provide medical and public health assistance in flood-affected areas of Bangladesh, reports UNB.

US Agency for International Development (USAID) through its Office of Foreign Disaster Assistance (OFDA) signed an agreement to this effect in Washington on September 23, according to a USIS release issued in the city yesterday.

The grant will be used to pro-

cure essential medicines, water purification tablets, high energy biscuits and other medical

UNICEF will work in collaboration with local implementing partners, including the ICDDR,B, CARE, Bangladesh and USAID-supported NGOs.






