If there is a strong wind, the fragile support would not be able to withstand the pressure, said an employee at the Certificate section at the second floor of the three-storied building.

The second floor of the building is the severely affected part where a number of DU students go everyday to collect their marksheets and certifi-The marksheet and certifi-


Bangladesh Scouts has also distributed towels and napkings to 37 new-born babies in different flood shelters with the assistance of Dhaka Sheraton Hotel.
