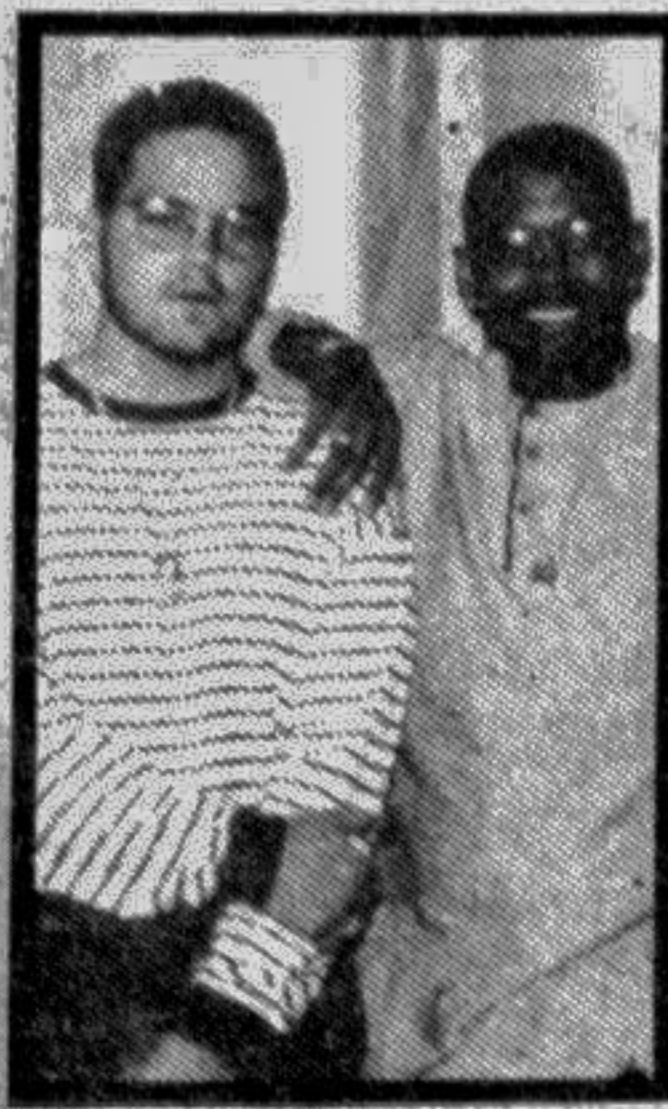


Pick of the week

SUPER SUNDAY: MR AND MRS BRIDGE

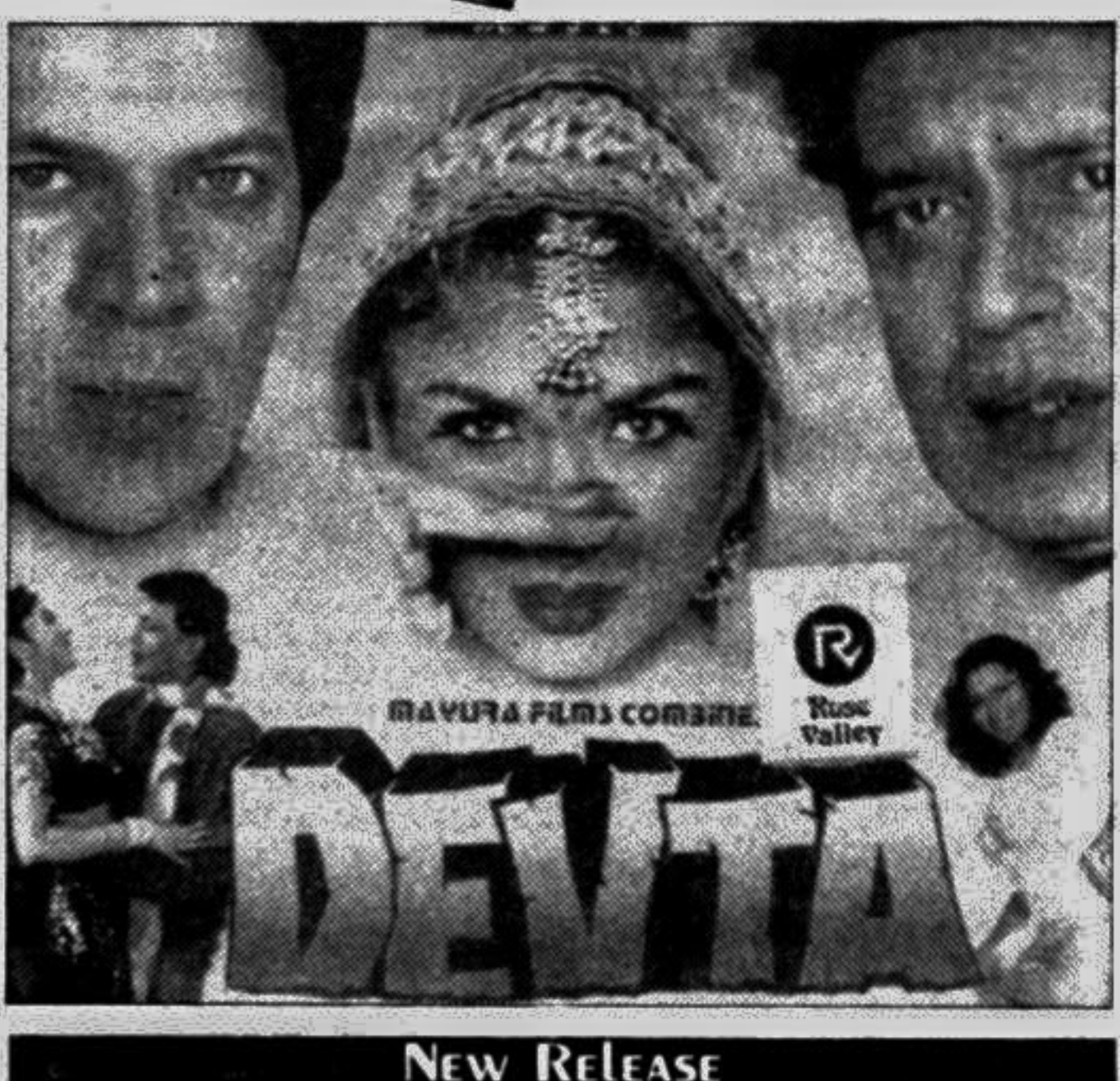

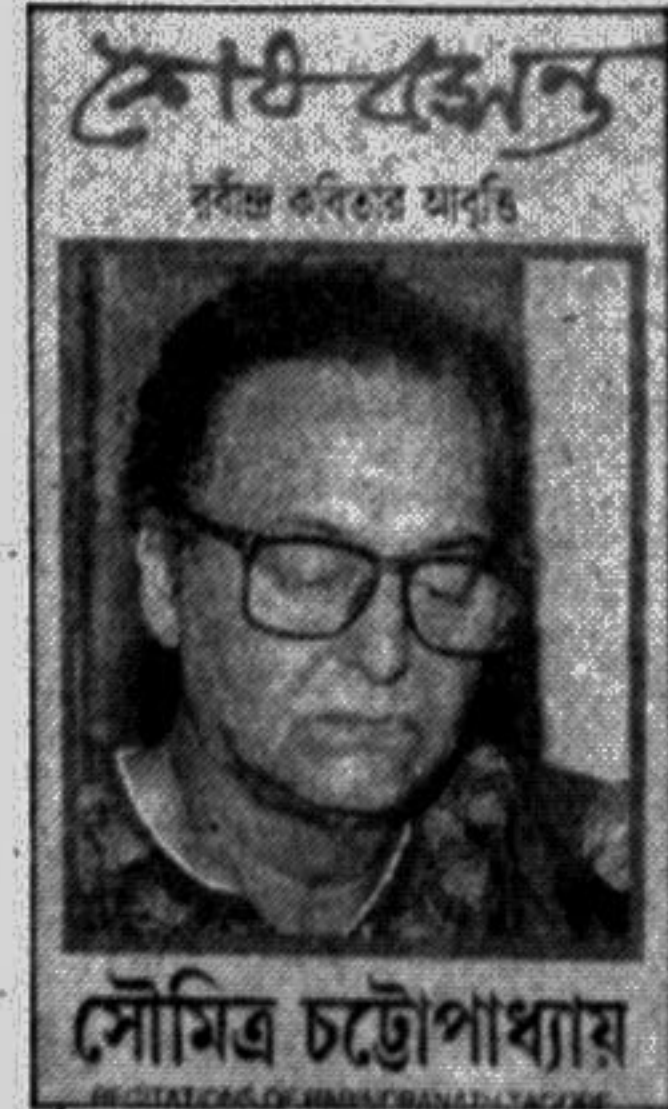
MUSICAL TRIBUTE TO NAZRUL

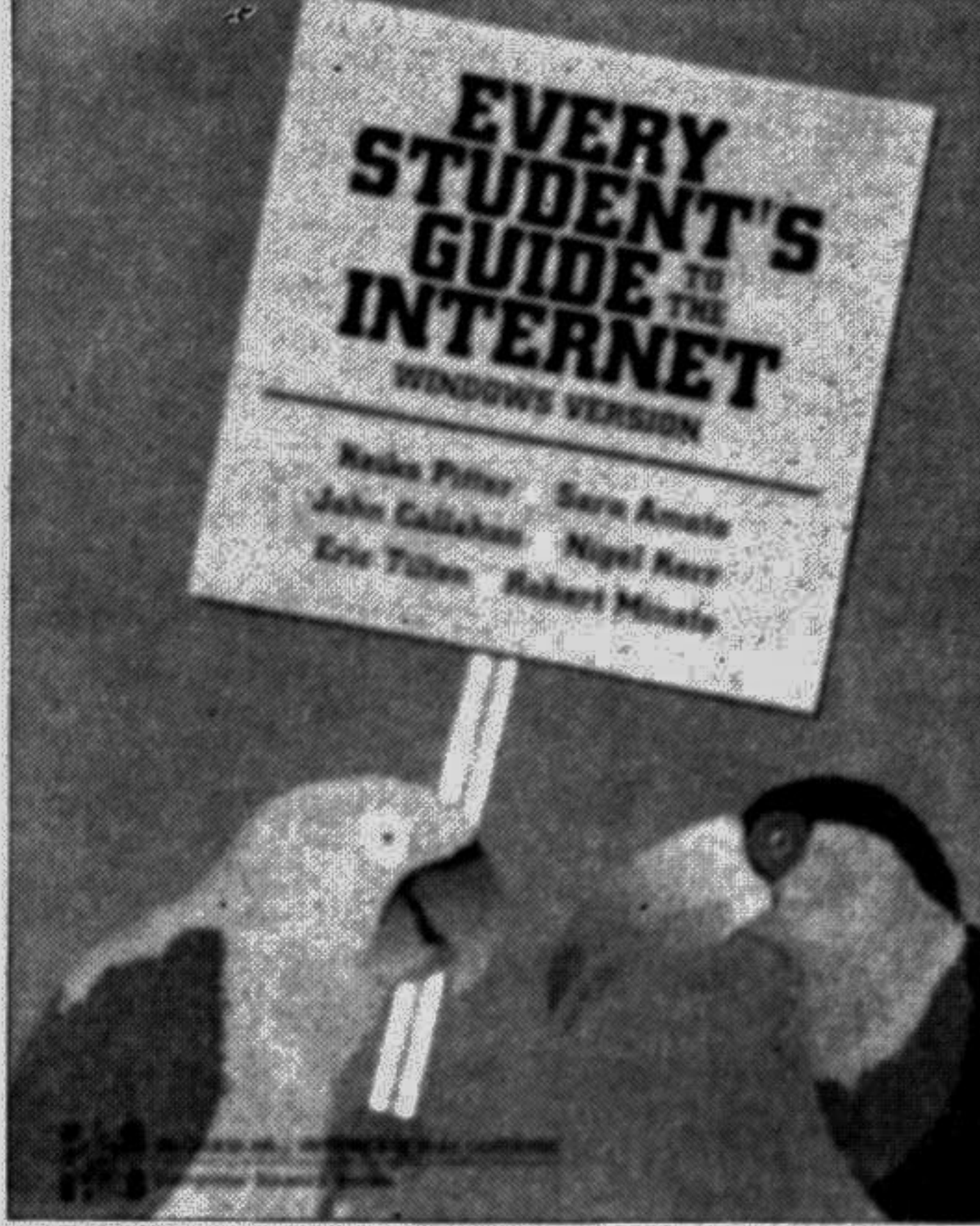

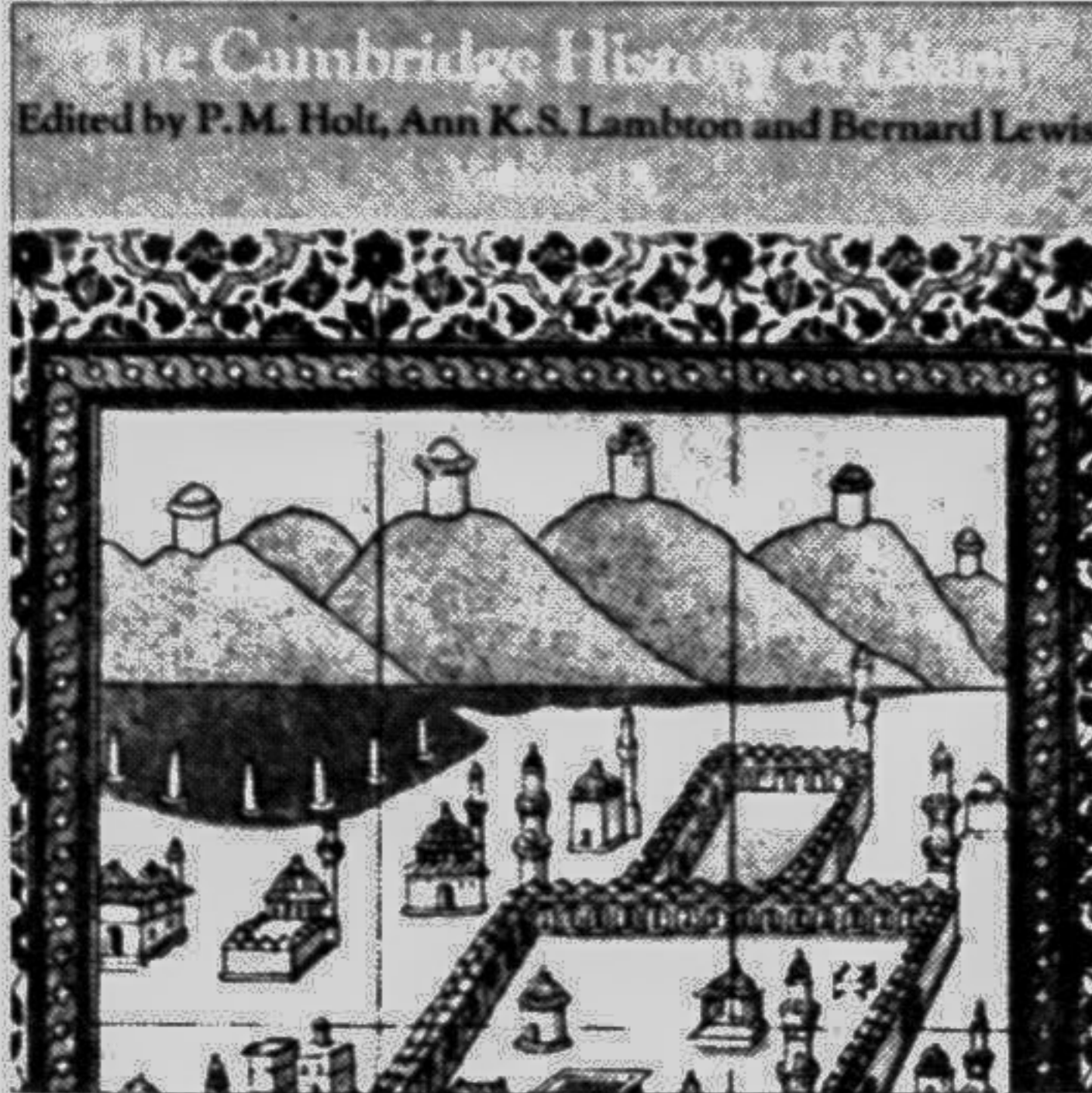

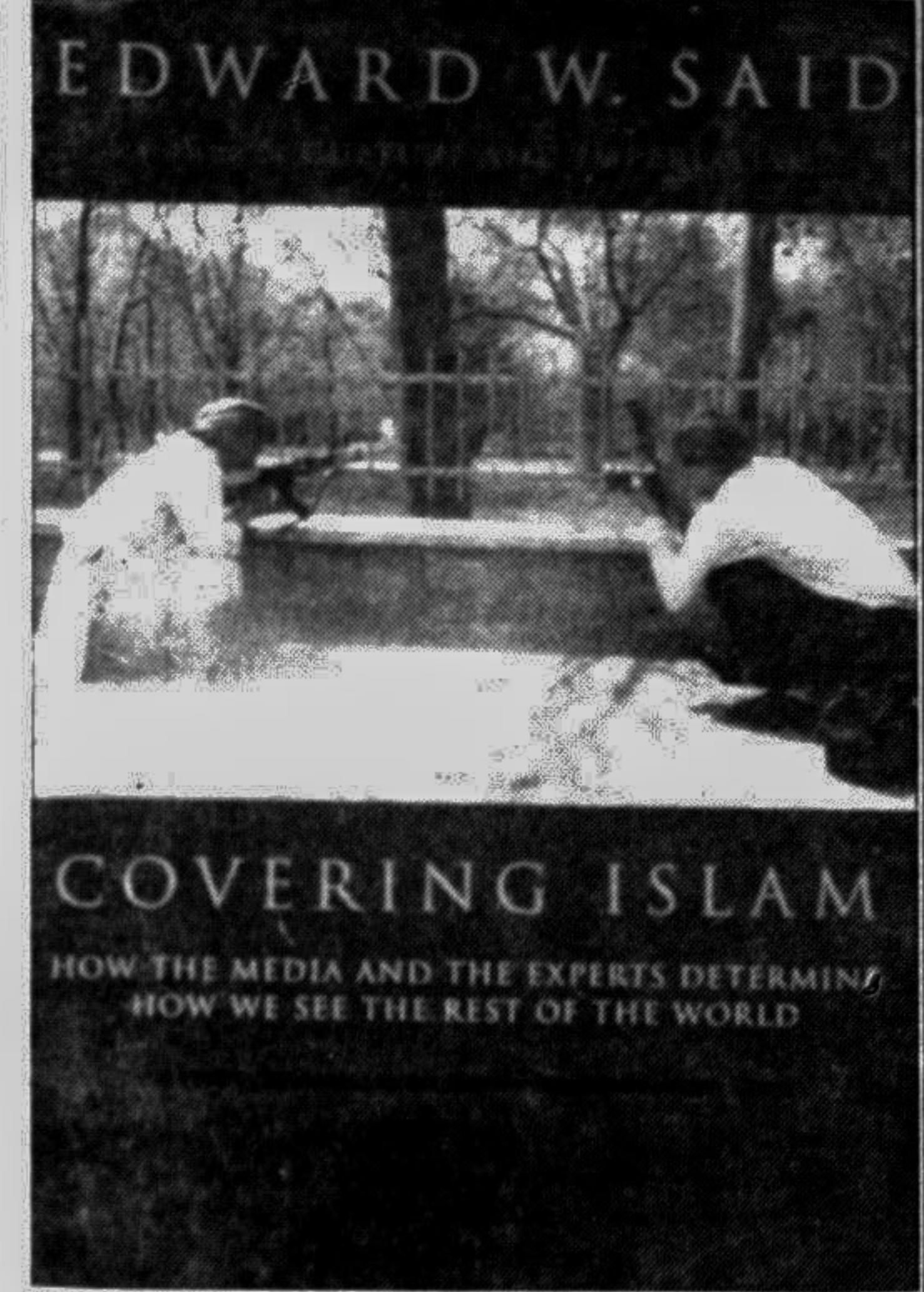


FATIMA MERNISSI

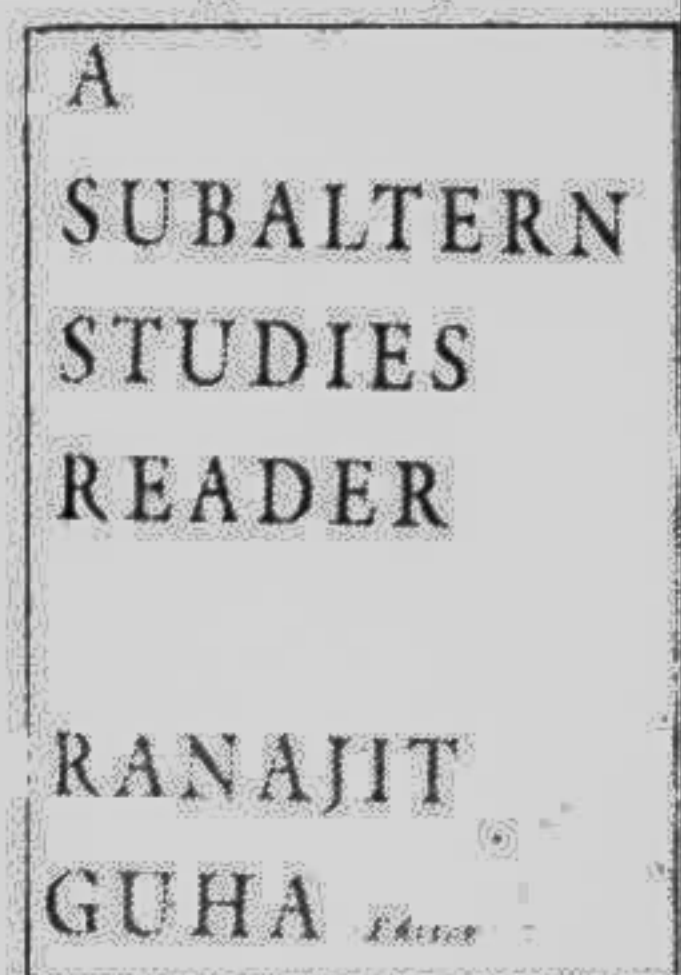
COVERING ISLAM

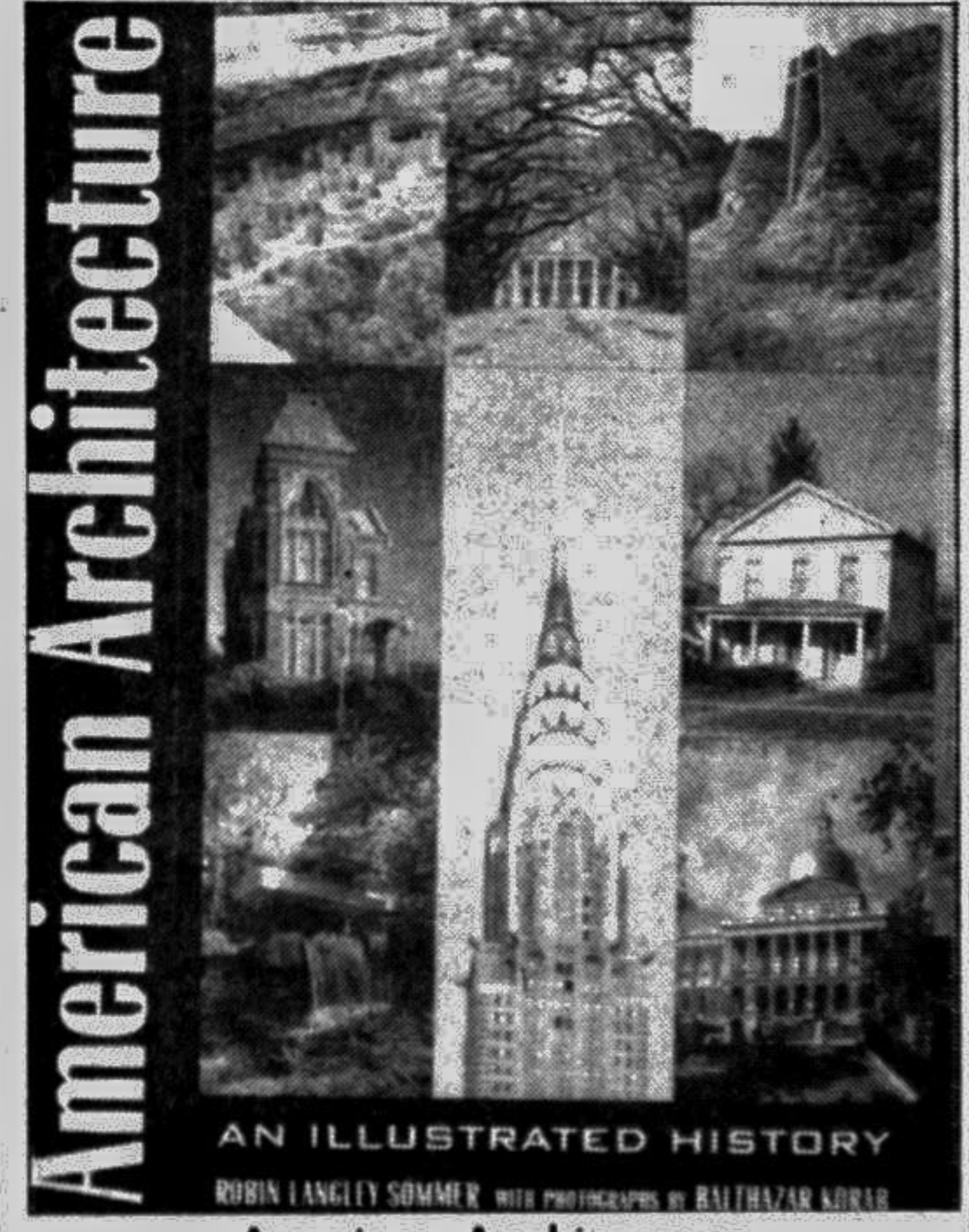
THREE HORSEMEN OF THE NEW APOCALYPSE
