RANGAMATI, Oct 10: Chairman of the Task Force on Repatriated Tribals and Internal Refugees Rehabilitation Affairs, Dipankar Talukdar, MP, reiterated today his appeal to the leaders of Partbattya Chattagram Jano Sanghati Samity (PCJSS) to accept the recently formed Chittagong Hill Tracts Regional Council in joining hands with government to complete the implementation of the remaining clauses of the peace accord properly and as early as possible. Terming the peace accord as

a long-expected and hardearned outcome of both the government and PCJSS, Dipankar urged the PCJSS leaders to join hands with government to expedite complete and smooth implementation of the peace accord for the betterment of the people of this region, battered terribly during the decadeslong insurgency. The government formed a

22-member Chittagong Hill Tracts regional council on September 6 last with President of PCJSS, Jyotirindra Bodhipriyo Larma as its chairman according to the spirit of the CHT peace accord signed late last year, for its sincere and proper implementation. Dipankar observed. As the government is sincere

to the peace accord and its implementation, it has, by this time, implemented a good number of clauses upholding its spirit, Dipankar said, adding that the speed in expediting the implementation is, of course, satisfactory in comparison with those signed in different countries of the world in the recent past. 


