Earlier in September, India sent medicines worth about Rs 40 lakh for the flood victims, it said.

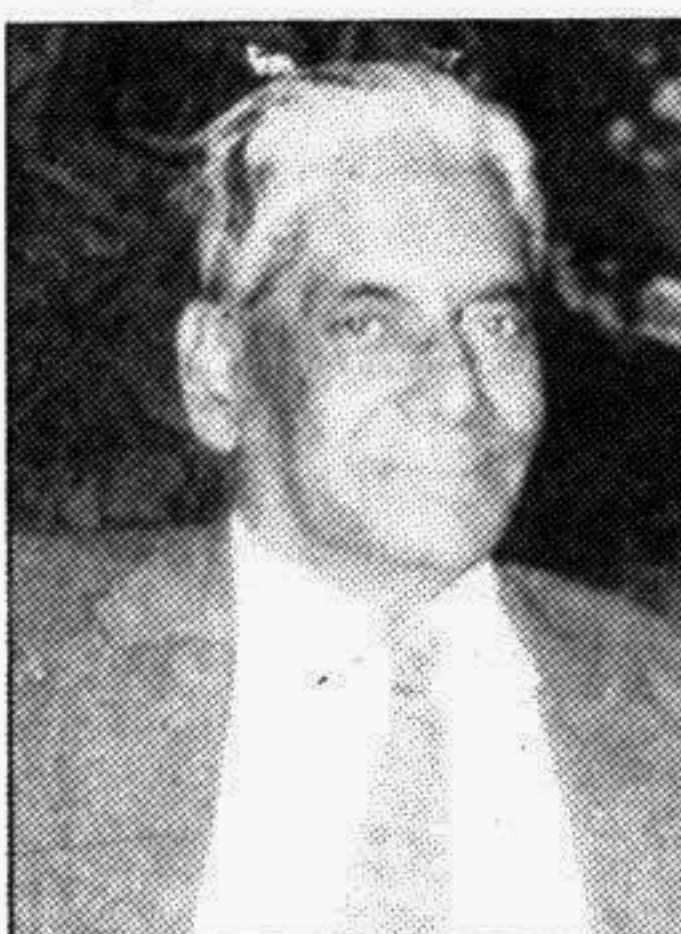
The government of India will also provide 20,000 tonnes of parboiled rice worth 5.2 million dollars later this month," the release added.
