Chhayanat's housing programme for flood-hit people

Chhayanat, a leading cultural organisation, launched a housing programme for the flood affected people of Ruhitpur union under Keraniganj thana yesterday.

A total of 30 families who lost homes in the deluge, will be provided with a house as part of the first phase of the programme. Founder Vice President of Chhayanat Waheedul Haque inaugurated the programme.

The housing programme initiated by Chhayanat in conjunction with Jatiya Rabindra Sangeet Sammilan Parishad and the well-wishers of Chhayanat in London would construct homes to the homeless of Ruhitpur, Kalatia, Shakta and Taranagar unions of Keraniganj thana.

Earlier, speakers at a discussion reviewed the relief operation conducted in the thana during the period of September 7 to September 24. A total of 5,500 local people were provided with one meal a day during the

period. The relief operation supported by local Awami League, Chhatra League, Mukti-juddher Chetona Mancha, Samilito Sangskritik Jote, Hamdard and Chhayanat was participated by over 100 local youths who delivered food to the doorsteps of people in the region.

The speakers stressed on agricultural rehabilitation programme and distribution of khas land among the landless people.

Among others Commander of Sector Number Eight in the Liberation War Colonel Abu Osman Chowdhury, general secretary of Bangladesh College University Teachers' Association Shahjahan Mia, general secretary of Chhayanat Khairul Anam Shakil, former president of Muktiyoddha Sangsad Anwar Hossain, artists Moksed Ali and Emdad Hossain and Nasim Hossain Apu of Muktiyuddher Chetona Mancha were present at the discussion.

BCL Dhaka (North) body announced

A 41-member new committee of ruling party's student wing Bangladesh Chhatra League Dhaka City (North) has been announced, reports UNB.

Saifullah Saiful has been elected president of the new committee, while Akkasur Rahman Akhi general secretary and Shamsuddin Lavlu organising secretary.

BCL general secretary Ishak Ali Khan Panna told the news agency that the committee was announced on Thursday night after a day-long conference of the City (North) unit.

PWA Meenabazar rescheduled

The two-day Meenabazar arranged by the Pakistan Women's Association (PWA) in aid of flood victims has been rescheduled as torrential rains disrupted the programme that was scheduled to begin yesterday, says a press release.

President of the association Farah Karam Elahi announced that the Meenabazar will now be held on October 23 and 24 at the Pakistan House in Gulshan 2.

Former minister clarifies position

Convenor of Jamalpur district BNP and former Deputy Minister for Health Serajul Haq yesterday denied the accuracy of the news items published in a section of the press regarding the death of the district Jubo Dal general secretary Anwarul Haq.

Protesting the news, he demanded exemplary punishment to the killers of Anwarul Haq. "I condemn and protest the news items which alleged my involvement centring the death of the Jubo Dal leader," the former minister said.

"A section of local Awami League leaders has been conspiring to tarnish my image and political career," he alleged. "I had no political enmity or rivalry with the late Jubo Dal leader as stated in some news items because he was much junior to me," the former minister said.
