

She stressed the need for preserving canals, lakes, beels, haors, ponds and other water bodies for maximum utilisation of surface water and also for massive plantation to protect environment.

The Prime Minister said the government has already decided to construct an embankment from Tongi to Demra for making the capital flood free. This embankment will later be turned into a ring road around the capital with a circular railway system.

"This government always stands beside you with its best will, capability and determination," she said. "We'll have to win over all odds and obstacles by utilising the united effort of the people and the government in a planned way."
