

Warne back with bang

MELBOURNE, Oct 24: Australian leg-spinner Shane Warne scored an unbeaten century in his first full match back from shoulder surgery today, reports Reuters.

Playing for St Kilda against Melbourne in a Victorian Club match, Warne hit 109 not out in his team's total of 128.

But Warne, who is hoping to be fit enough to play against England at some stage of the forthcoming Ashes series, did not bowl as Melbourne amassed 332.

England open their tour, with a one-day match against the Australian Cricket Board Chairman's XI at Lilac Hill in Perth on Thursday.

Andre in semis

OSTRAVA, Czech Republic, Oct 24: Andre Agassi fought back from four games down in the final set to beat Sweden's Thomas Johansson 6-7, 6-4, 6-4 on Friday for a place in the Czech Indoor semifinals, reports Reuters.

The second-seeded American, who mixed moments of magic with mistakes in front of a packed house, saved four set points before losing the first-set tie-break 6-8.

Agassi's break in the fifth game of the second set seemed to show his play was back on track.

But then the wheels came off again in the third set as the 21st-ranked Swede swept the first four games, breaking Agassi's serve twice, seemingly at will.

With the crowd cheering wildly for him, the American rediscovered his serve and strung together six games of frenetic, vintage Agassi tennis to put out the eight seeded Swede.

Agassi, who at age 27 has marched up the ATP rankings from outside the top 100 to sixth in the world over the past year, now faces Zimbabwe's Wayne Black.

Australia nicely placed



KARACHI, Pakistan, Oct 24: An unbroken 103-run second wicket partnership between skipper Mark Taylor and Justin Langer today edged Australia closer to their first Test series win in Pakistan for 39 years, reports Reuters.

At the close of the third day of the third Test, Australia, 1-0 ahead in the three-match series, were 130 for one in their second innings — an overall lead of 158.

Taylor was 64 and Langer 45. Earlier, Taylor's opposite number Amir Sohail had been instrumental in guiding his side to within 28 runs of Australia's first innings total of 280 with a gutsy 133.

It was Sohail's fifth Test century and second against Australia.

Despite suffering from a chest infection and high temperature, Sohail batted for a little under six hours and faced 272 balls. His innings was spiced with 18 boundaries and a

six off leg-spinner Stuart MacGill. Sohail, 83 not out overnight, was involved in a face-saving 98-run seventh wicket partnership with former captain Wasim Akram after paceman Glenn McGrath had left Pakistan reeling at 69 for five on Friday evening.

The partnership ended when Akram was trapped leg before by MacGill for 35.

McGrath added the scalp of Shaheer Ahmed to finish with five for 66. It was the 10th time in 40 Tests that he had bagged five wickets or more in an innings.

Sohail's defiant innings ended second ball after lunch when Langer took a spectacular catch at square leg off Colin Miller.

When Australia batted a second time they shrugged off the loss of Michael Slater for 11 to take a firm grip on the game.

Taylor had several anxious moments in his 178-ball 64. When he had made just four a Wasim Akram throw failed to hit the stumps at the non-strik-

er's end with the Australian skipper stranded in the middle of the pitch.

Then on 25 he survived a very close bat-and-pad decision off Arshad Khan. Television replays suggested the ball had taken the edge of Taylor's bat.

He was let off again by Amir Sohail at square leg when he had made 56.

Langer played a watchful, patient innings, scoring his runs from 123 balls with just two fours and a six off Shaheer.

Conspiracy theory



LAHORE, Oct 24: A senior Pakistani cricket official said today that accusations of gambling and match-fixing were part of a conspiracy aimed at ruining the reputations of some of the country's international players, reports Reuters.

Khalid Mahmood, chairman of the Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB), was speaking after giving evidence to a judge investigating charges of betting and match-fixing.

"I think it is an internal conspiracy against some senior players to get them out of the side," Mahmood said "I don't even rule out the possibility of a

campaign hatched by the west.

"Last time the allegations were levelled a year before the World Cup. Similar has happened this time.

Mahmood was referring to accusations by Australian cricketers Shane Warne, Tim Langer and Mark Waugh five months after the 1994 tour of Pakistan.

Salim Malik, who was accused of offering the trio a bribe to throw the Karachi Test, was exonerated of all charges but was stripped of the captaincy.

Mahmood was said to have told the investigating judge during the hearing that he had no knowledge of any foul play.

He, however, said he was interested to know if any of the

Pakistan team players were really involved," Ali Sibtain Fazli, lawyer for the PCB, said.

He appeared before justice Malik Mohammad Qayyum and told him that he was associated with the Pakistan team on the 1993 tour of the West Indies and did not see anything.

Aaquib Javed, Pakistan's discarded Test paceman, alleged at an earlier hearing that during Pakistan's 1994 tour of Sri Lanka he had received a telephone call from one of the players in which he was directed to contact an alleged bookmaker

who would deposit five million rupees in his bank account and would also provide him with a vehicle for personal use.

Taylor subject of toilet jokes!

SYDNEY, Oct 24: Australian cricket captain Mark Taylor's record-matching score in Pakistan has led to possible legal action over toilet paper, reports AFP.

A newspaper advert for a toilet paper has led Taylor's manager John Fordham to take legal advice.

The advert was a play on Taylor's success in a Test match in Pakistan when he equalled Sir Don Bradman's Australian record with a not-out score of 334.

"Tubby, it's good to see you with the runs again," the advert read over the picture of a four roll pack of toilet paper.

Below was the line: "the gentlest way to start the day."

Taylor, is known as tubby in Australia, although he claims to have lost weight for the current series in Pakistan where he has re-found his run-scoring touch.

Fordham said the ad was run without Taylor's permission. "It is very, very bad taste and very offensive," Fordham said. "It is very clear that they mean Mark Taylor so we have taken appropriate action," he added.

Carroll dead

DUBLIN, Oct 24: Former leading Irish athlete Noel Carroll died suddenly Friday after suffering a suspected heart attack during a training session, reports AFP.

Carroll, 56, represented his country in two Olympics and three European Championships.

A strong advocate of clean living and physical fitness, Carroll had been European 800m champion and was also world veteran athletics champion at the same distance.

He was the chief executive officer of Dublin Chamber of Commerce at the time of his death and had been well-known as the public spokesman for the city's corporation for 25 years.
